



Quarantine Order Allowance Scheme

The Quarantine Order Allowance (QOA) Scheme is set up to mitigate financial impact for those who have been served Quarantine Orders under the Infectious Diseases Act.

Under the QOA scheme, claims of \$100 per day can be made by two groups:

- (i) Self-employed
- (ii) Employers, who have employees issued with Quarantine Orders

The following groups are eligible to claim for the QOA:

Self-employed	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident• Show proof of employment• Must not break quarantine order
Employers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Registered company in Singapore• Employees must be Singapore Citizen, Permanent Residents or Workpass holders• Show proof of payment to employees when they are under quarantine• Employees must not break quarantine order

Note:

This allowance will not apply if the affected S Pass or Work Permit holders began their QO on or after 1 April 2020, regardless of when the QO ends. This is in view of the levy rebate and waiver of March 2020's levies (payable in April 2020).
