Clinical Criteria for Long-Term and Home PN for MediShield Life Coverage and MediSave Use

Long-term and Home PN Patients must meet criteria in Section 1 and be diagnosed with a condition listed in Section 2 to qualify for MediShield Life coverage and MediSave use.

Section 1 Patients must meet both Criteria 1 and

1. The patient will require PN for a minimum of 90 days,

- 2. The patient must have a disease of the stomach and/or intestine which significantly:
 - impairs the absorption of nutrients, OR
 - impairs the ability of nutrients to be transported through the GI system.

Section 2

Patients must be diagnosed with any one condition A-H

Recent massive Small Bowel Resection leaving less than or equal Α. to 1.5 metres of small bowel beyond the ligament of Treitz.

<u>or</u>

B. **Short Bowel Syndrome:**

- Severe enough to show evidence of fluid and electrolyte malabsorption AND
- GI Fluid intake of 2.5-3 L/day resulting in enteral losses that exceed 50% of the oral/enteral intake

<u>or</u>

- C. Need for Prolonged Bowel Rest for at least 3 months and requiring intravenously 20-35 cal/kg/day for:
 - Symptomatic Pancreatitis OR
 - Severe exacerbation of Regional Enteritis OR
 - Proximal Enterocutaneous Fistula where tube feeding distal to the fistula is not possible

<u>or</u>

D. Complete Mechanical Small Bowel Obstruction where surgery is not an option.

or

E.Malnourishment and severe fat malabsorption as evidenced by:

- 10% documented weight loss over ≤ 3 months, **AND**
- Serum albumin ≤35 g/L, AND
- Severe fat malabsorption where faecal fat exceeds 50% of oral/enteral intake on a diet of at least 50gms of fat/day as measured by a standard 72-hour faecal fat test

or

F. Malnourished and severe motility disturbance as evidenced by:

- 10% documented weight loss over ≤ 3 months, **AND**
- Serum albumin ≤35 g/L, AND
- Severe motility disturbance of the small intestine and/or stomach unresponsive to prokinetic medications demonstrated scintigraphically or radiographically.

<u>or</u>

G. Paediatric patients:

- Unable to sustain fluid and nutritional requirements for weight gain, **AND**
- Diagnosed with:
 - Motility Disorders, evidenced by radiological, histology or manometry findings, **OR**
 - Congenital Diarrheal Disorders with an identified osmotic or secretory cause, OR

Short Bowel Syndrome with inadequate absorptive capacity or
 H. Advanced Cancer Patients with Intestinal Failure, in whom:

 Prognosis ≥ 3 months, AND
 Eastern Cooperative Oncology Group (ECOG) score 0-2, AND

Non-functioning GI tract (due to obstructions, fistulae etc.), AND
 HPN is agreed as indicated care by an Oncologist and a Palliative Medicine specialist
