

Venues for Marriage Solemnisations and Receptions

From 4 August 2020, marriage solemnisations may be held in the following places:

- Home, ROM/M Building and designated areas at the National Museum of Singapore operated by ROM: Up to 10 persons, excluding Solemniser and vendors.
- External venues such as places of worship, HDB common areas, hotels, restaurants (subject to venue owners'/ operators' policies and capacity). Up to 50 persons, excluding Solemniser and vendors. Please check with respective venue owners/ operators for details.

From 4 August 2020, wedding receptions may be held at external venues such as hotels and restaurants, with up to 50 persons excluding vendors. Please check with respective venue owners/ operators for details. We are exploring the possibility of expanding the list to include more venues such as HDB common areas, and will release details subsequently.

Venue owners may determine if and when to allow solemnisations and receptions to be held in their premises, and may set additional conditions for their use, such as setting a lower limit for attendance based on their capacity or ability to ensure safe management measures are implemented.
