

REVISION TO PER CAPITA HOUSEHOLD INCOME (PCHI) CRITERIA TO QUALIFY FOR MOH HEALTHCARE SUBSIDY SCHEMES AND SERVICES

Tables 1 to 12 below detail the revised PCHI criteria for each scheme/service. The tables should be read together with the following notes:

- (i) For patients/beneficiaries with no household income, i.e. PCHI of \$0, their subsidy shall be based on the Annual Value (AV) of the property reflected in his NRIC address (i.e. residential address of household).
- (ii) Some of the schemes also have other criteria, such as annual value of the property of residence, age and disability assessment, which will affect the household's subsidy eligibility for these schemes. Such non-PCHI eligibility criteria remain unchanged.
