Enterprises may maintain their own SMMs as company policy if they wish, for workplace health and safety, or for business continuity reasons.

<sup>^</sup> Mask wearing is required in (i) patient-facing areas, (ii) when there is face-to-face interactions with patients, and/or (iii) when care is being delivered to patients. Healthcare and residential care facilities include hospitals and polyclinics, private primary care and dental facilities, specialist facilities, TCM clinics, renal dialysis centres, clinical and radiological laboratories, residential care homes (such as nursing homes), COVID-19 care facilities, testing centres and vaccination centres, as well as ambulances and medical transport vehicles. MSF will also apply this requirement to Homes for the elderly.
