

Key Safe Management Measures for Marriage Solemnisations and Receptions

1. Group Size Limit

- 1.1. Limited to 50 persons (or lower depending on venue capacity and/or policy), throughout entire marriage solemnization/ reception, excluding Solemnizer (for solemnization), vendors and premise staff. Nevertheless, vendors and premise staff should be kept to a minimum.
- 1.2. Guests should be split into fixed groups of up to 5 persons each, with no intermingling or mixing between groups. An exception may be made for a designated core “wedding party” comprising up to 20 persons (including the bride and groom).
- 1.3. At least one-metre safe distancing must be observed between groups, as well as between the “wedding party” and other groups, at all times.

2. Use of Face Masks

- 2.1. All attendees are to wear masks at all times, with the exception of the bride and groom who may wear face shields instead. Masks may be removed momentarily for photo-taking.

3. Food and Beverage

- 3.1. Self-service buffets are not allowed.
- 3.2. No sale or consumption of alcohol is allowed after 10.30pm.

4. Contact Tracing

- 4.1. All guests should check in to the event using SafeEntry.
- 4.2. All guests should download and activate TraceTogether before attending the event.

5. High-risk Activities

- 5.1. Live performances or activities involving singing or loud talking/shouting are not allowed.
