

## **Certification of Competency in Administration of Medication with Tech-Enablement for Enrolled Nurses**

### **Course objective**

The course aims to equip enrolled nurses with skills and knowledge to enable them to administer medication across care setting safely.

### **Curriculum details**

The course covers the following topics:

- Fundamentals of nursing pharmacology
- Nursing roles and safety considerations of medical administration
- Calculation of drug dosage according to medication orders
- Medication administration management
- Identifying the common medications for the top 6 national chronic diseases
- Incorporation of various smart solutions and technologies, drawing on the experience and examples from ITE

### **Eligibility Criteria**

Participants must:

- Be at least an EN with minimum 2 years of working experience
- Possess a valid practising certificate enrolled with Singapore Nursing Board (SNB)
- Be recommended by their healthcare organisation
- Have an assigned clinical preceptor to endorse On-the-Job Training (OJT) competency checklist

### **Course Duration**

The course duration is 120 hours, which comprises 46 hours of theory, and 10 hours of practical lessons, and 64 hours (8 weeks) of OJT by the trainee's own clinical settings.
