Fee Caps at CHAS GP clinics

From 1 November 2020, eligible Singaporeans will receive subsidies for nationally-recommended vaccinations and childhood developmental screening at CHAS GP clinics. The fees will be capped as detailed in the table below.

Subsidies at Polyclinics

From 1 November 2020, adult Singaporeans will receive up to 75% subsidy for NAIS vaccinations at polyclinics. Pioneer Generation and Merdeka Generation seniors will also receive an additional 50% and 25% subsidy from their subsidised vaccination bills respectively. Prices after government subsidies are expected to be similar to that at the CHAS GP clinics.
