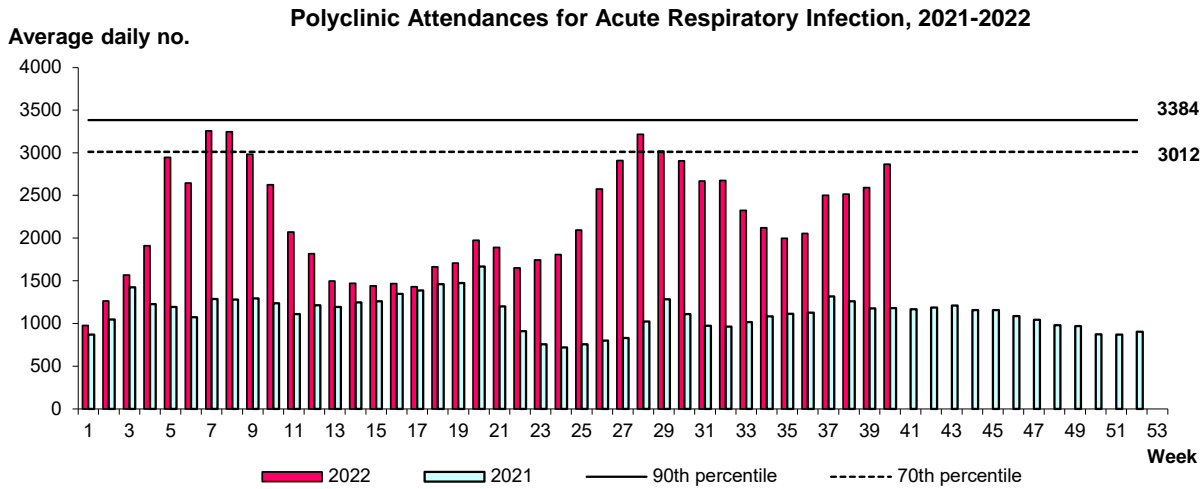

## Influenza Situation in Singapore 2022

Influenza indicators for E-week 40 (2 - 8 Oct 2022) are as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI is 2865 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 40.

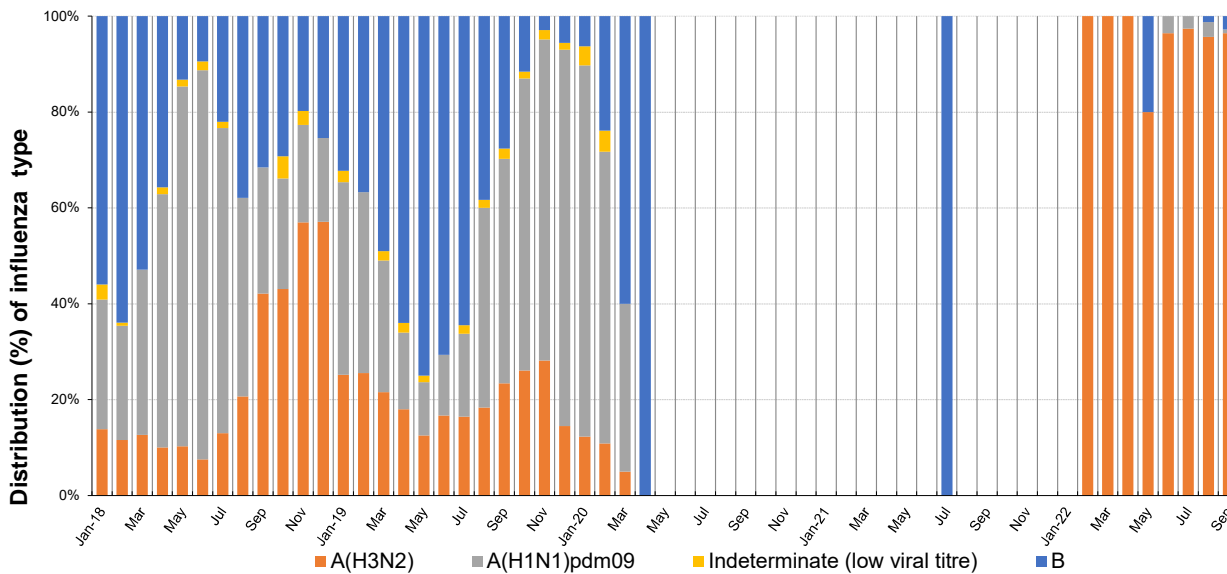


The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI is 0.8.

The overall positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 1102) in the community was 22.8% in the past 4 weeks.

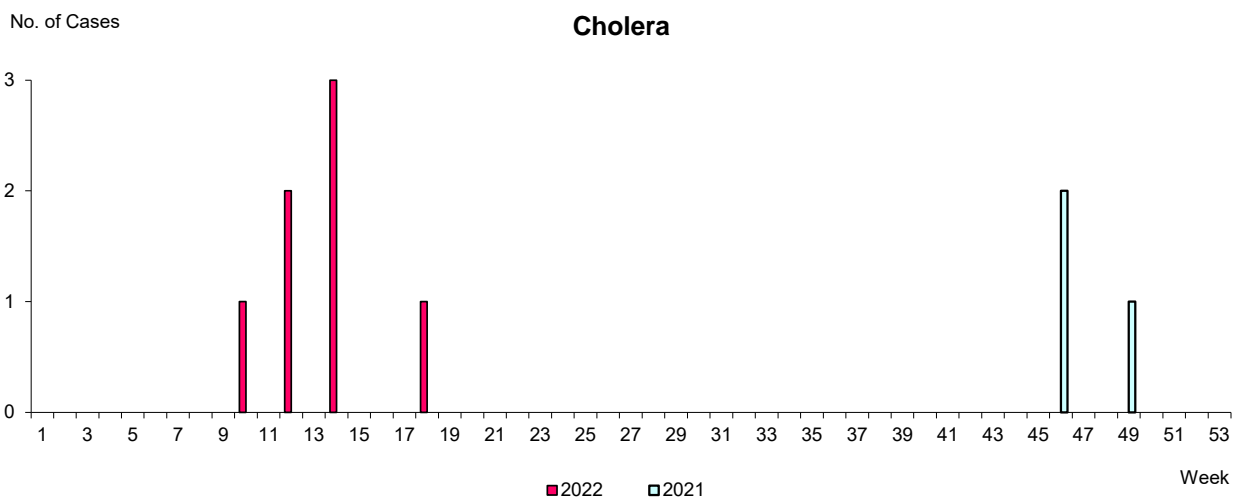
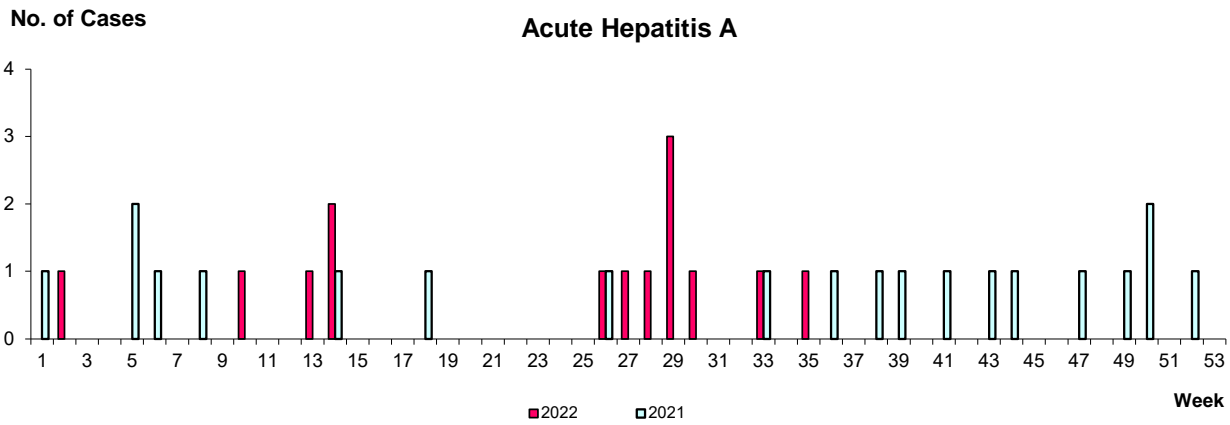
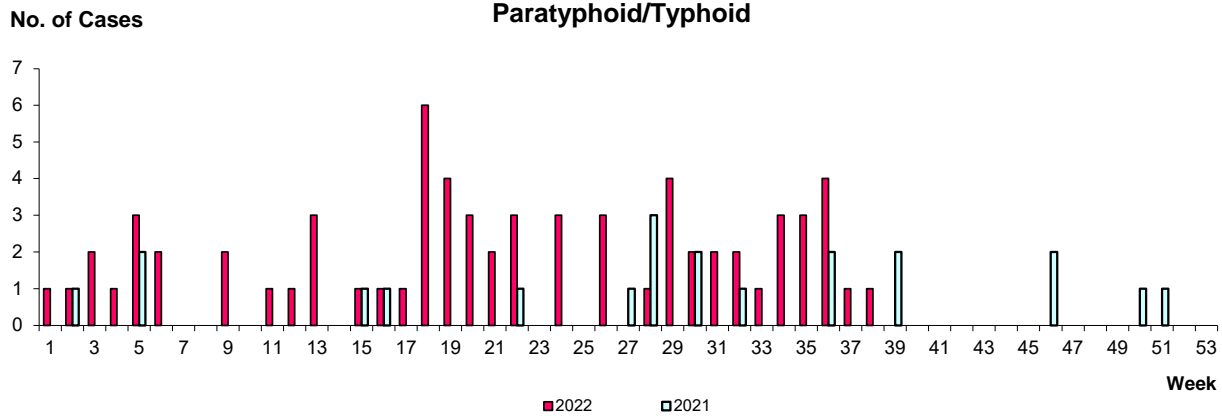
Of the 253 specimens tested positive for influenza in Sep 2022, 244 were positive for Influenza A(H3N2) (96.4%), 2 were positive for Influenza A(pH1N1) (0.8%) and 7 were positive for Influenza B (2.8%).

## Monthly Influenza Surveillance



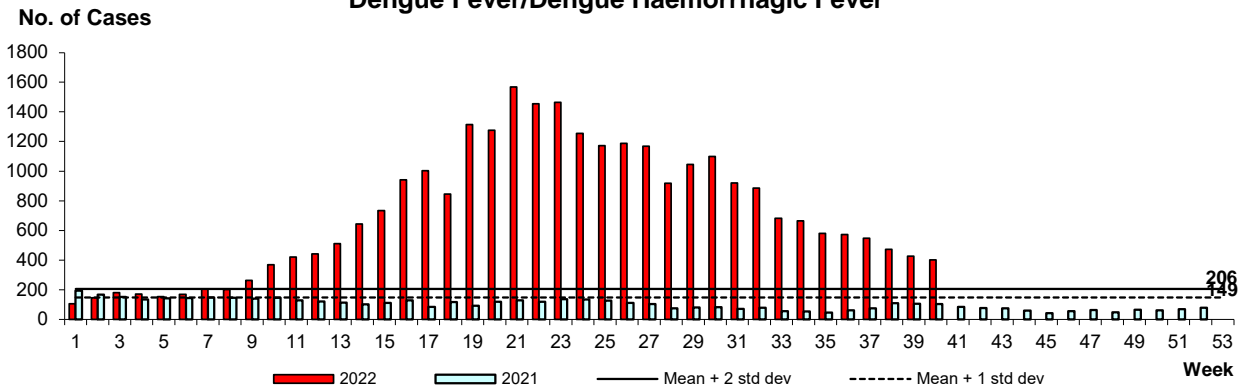

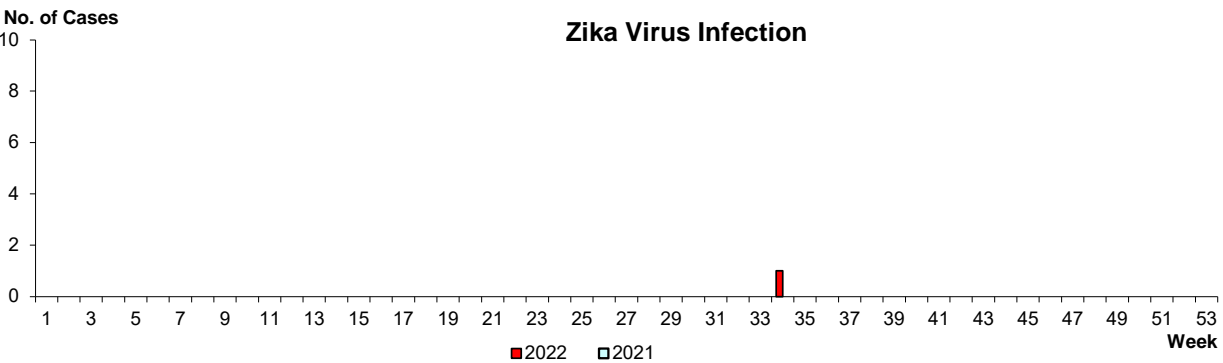
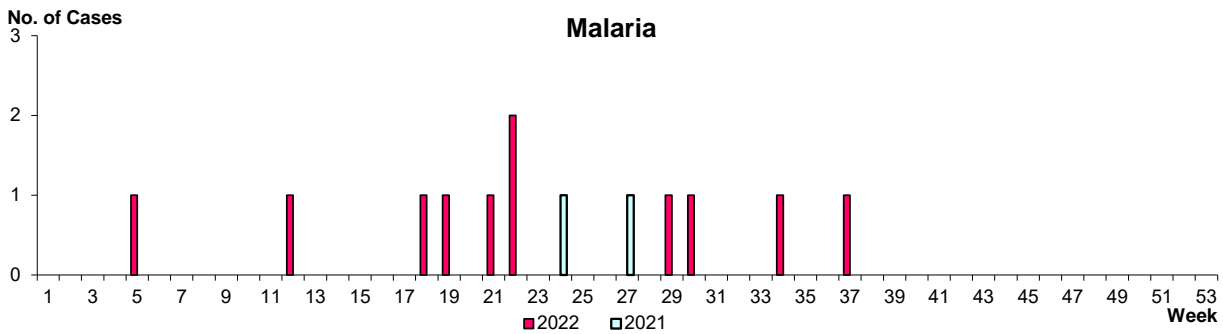
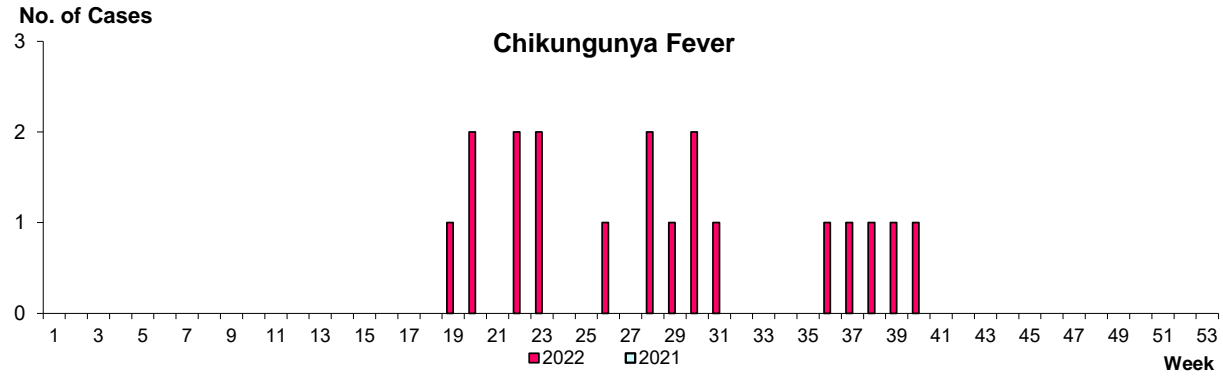
**Dengue Fever/Dengue Haemorrhagic Fever**



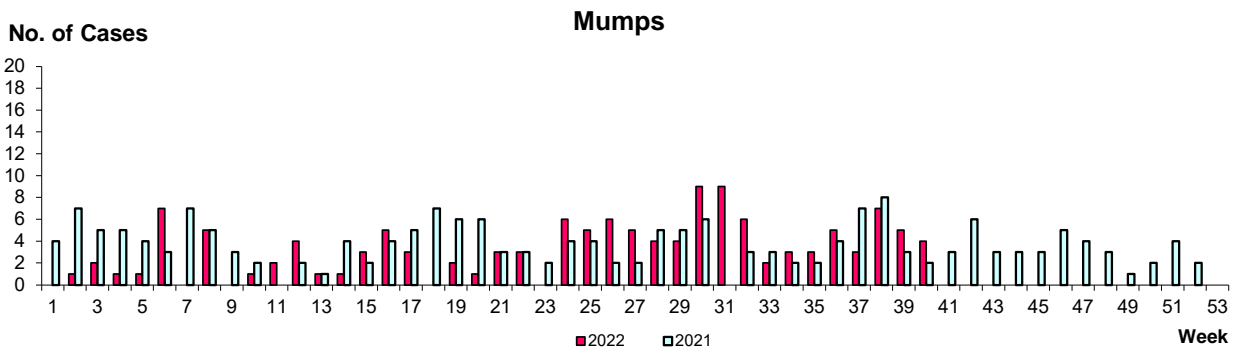
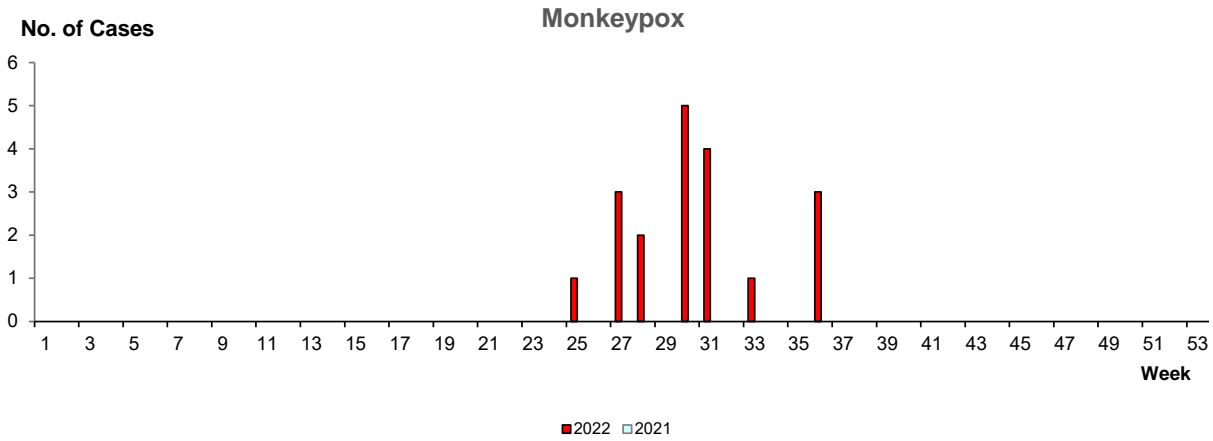
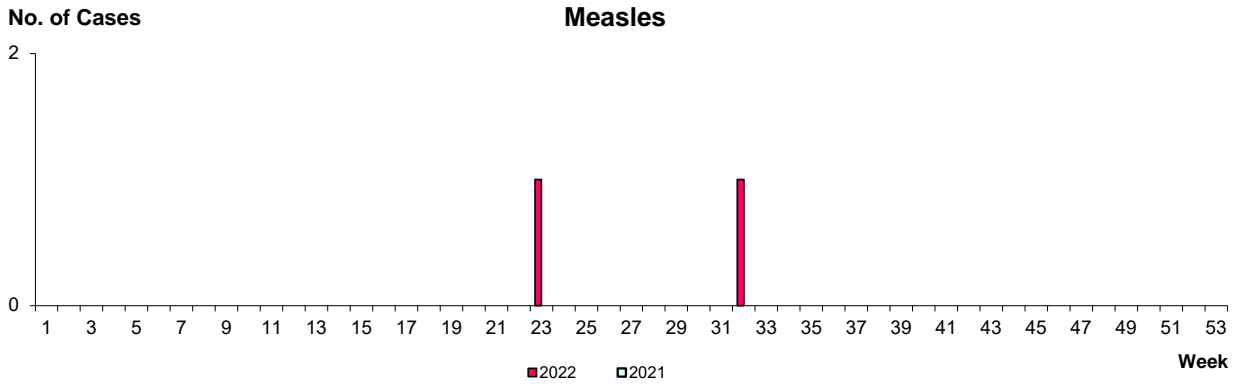
The number of dengue notifications was 402 in E-week 40.

The number of hospital admissions decreased to 42 in e-week 40 compared to 43 in e-week 39.

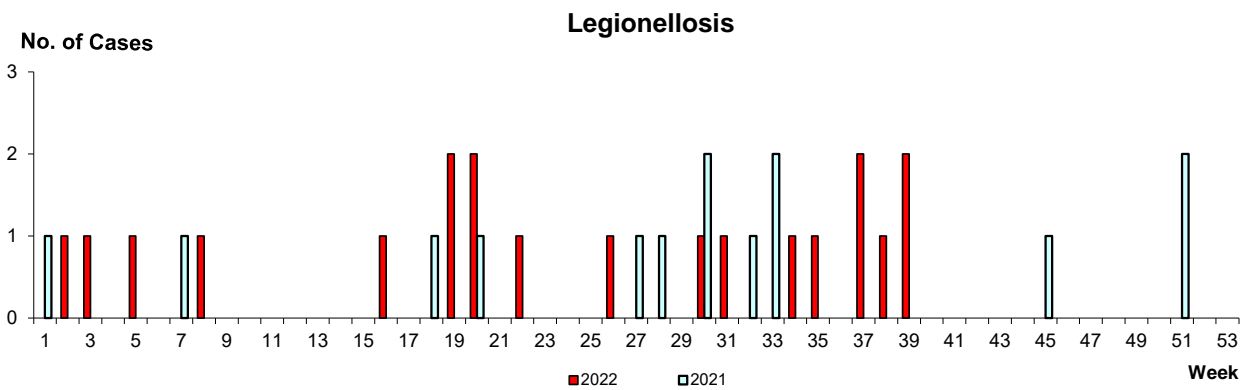
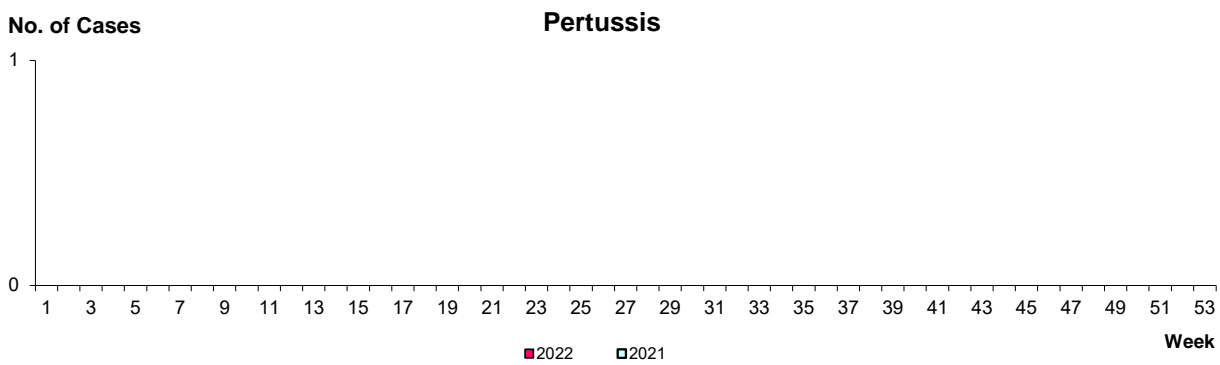
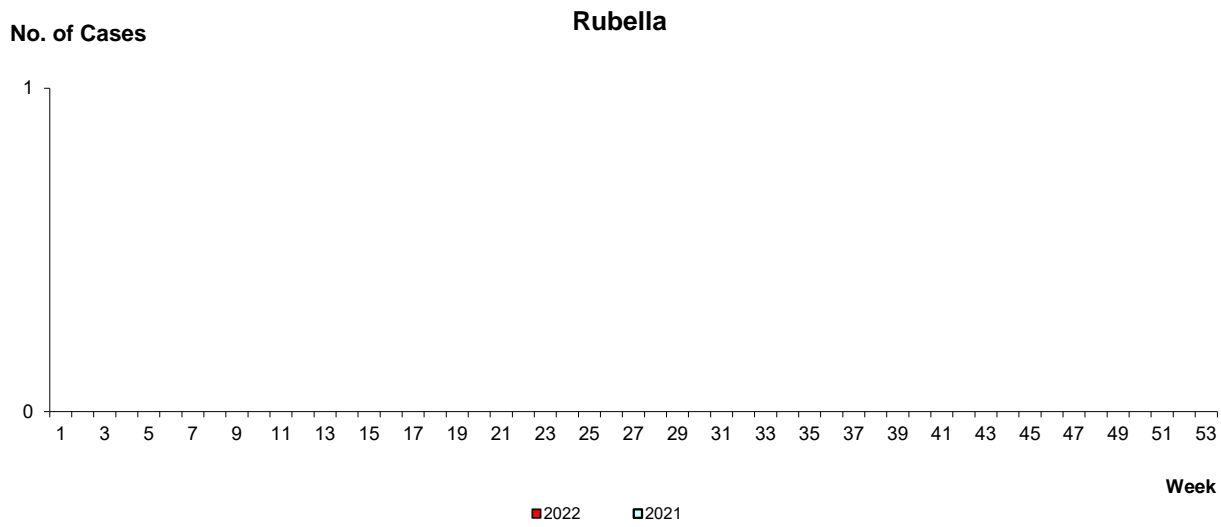

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2021-2022

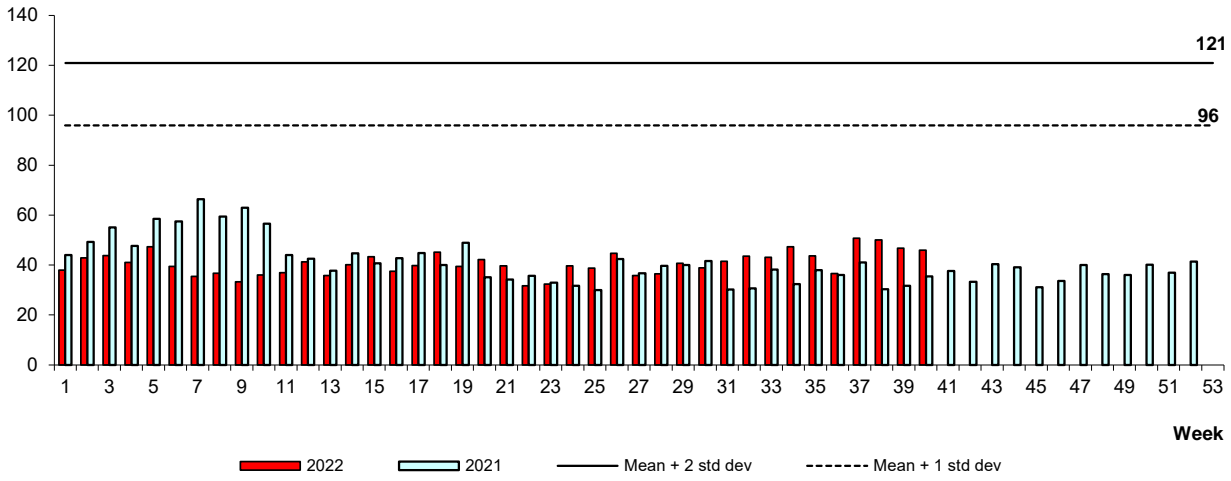

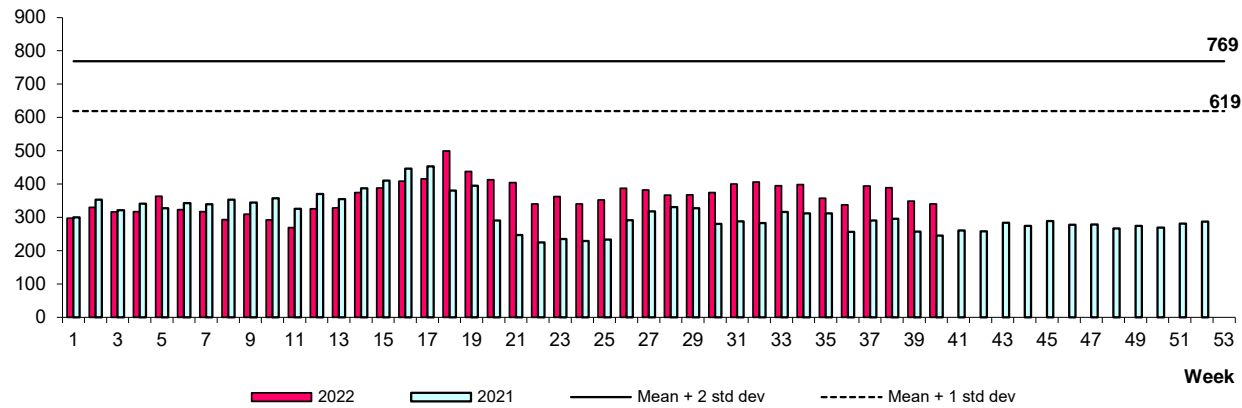
