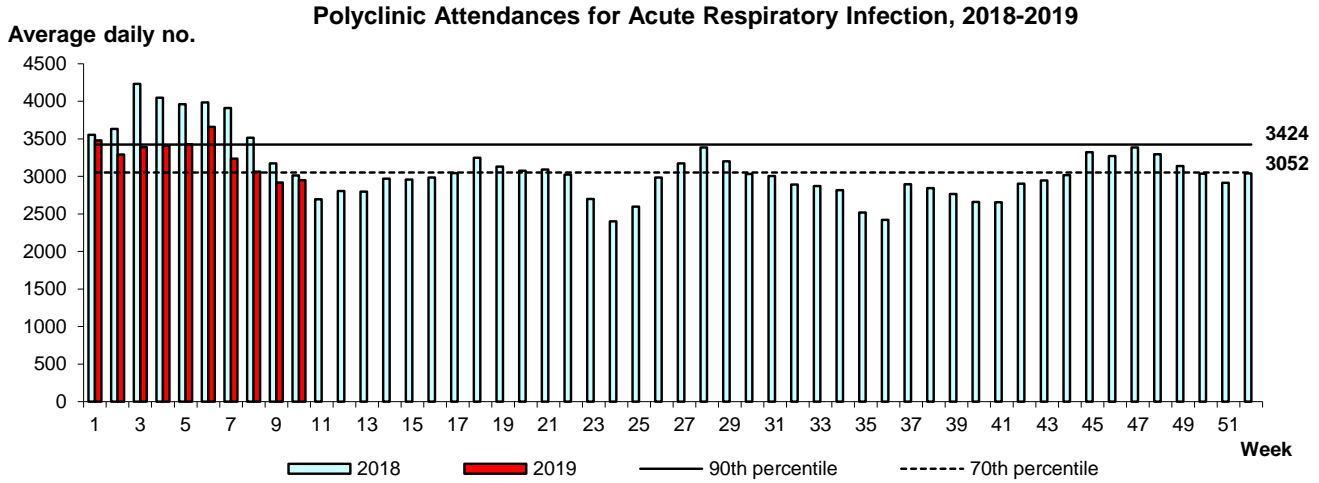

Influenza indicators for E-week 10 (3 - 9 Mar 2019) are as follows:

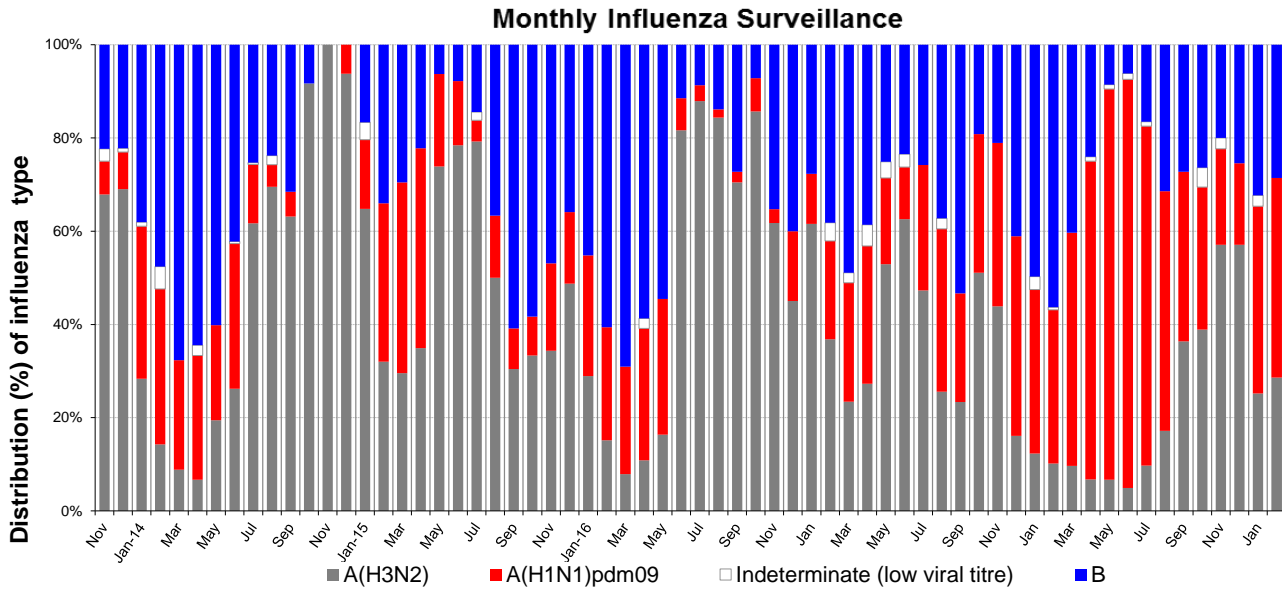
The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI is 2949 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 10.

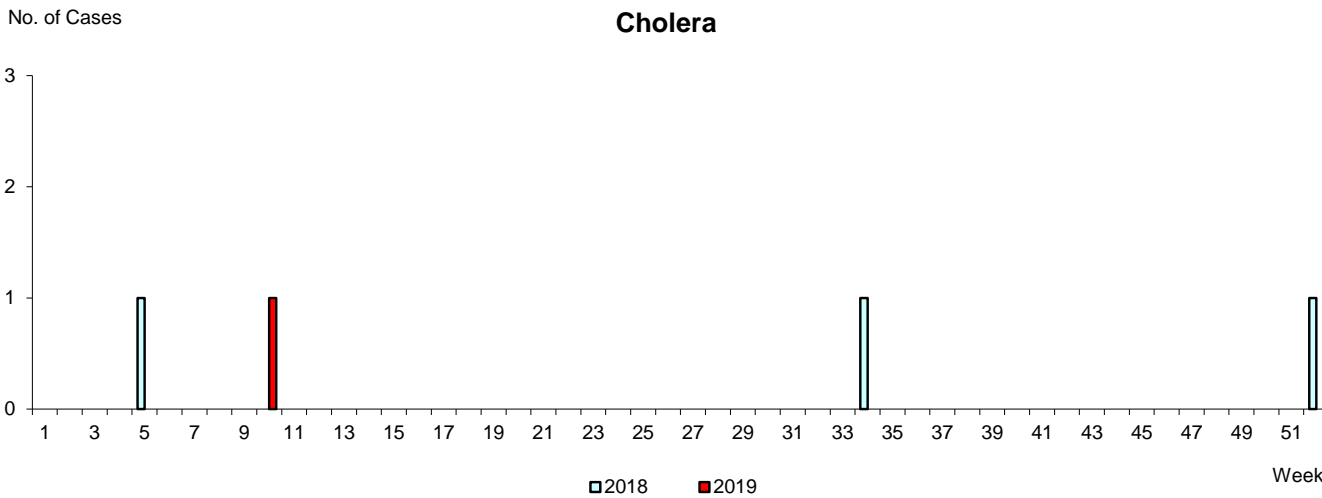
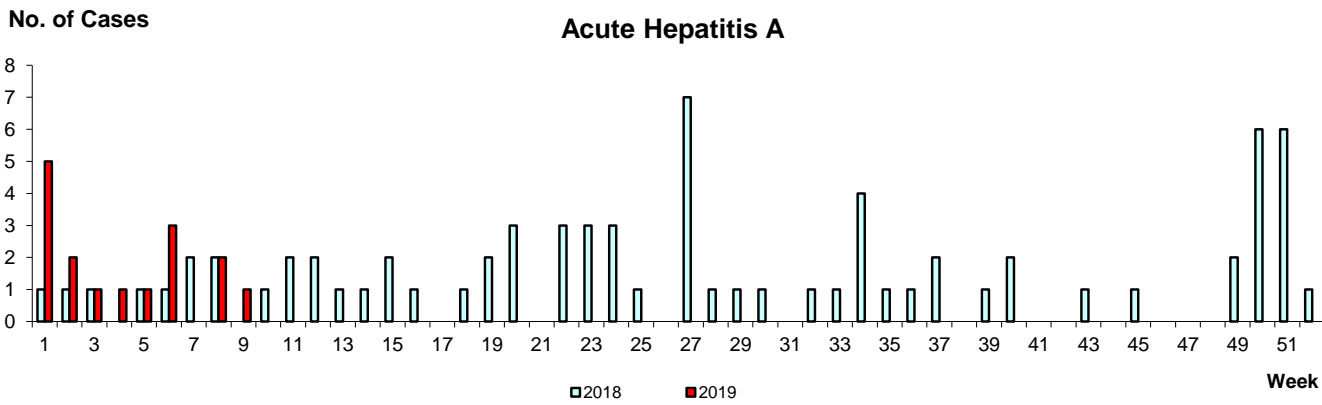
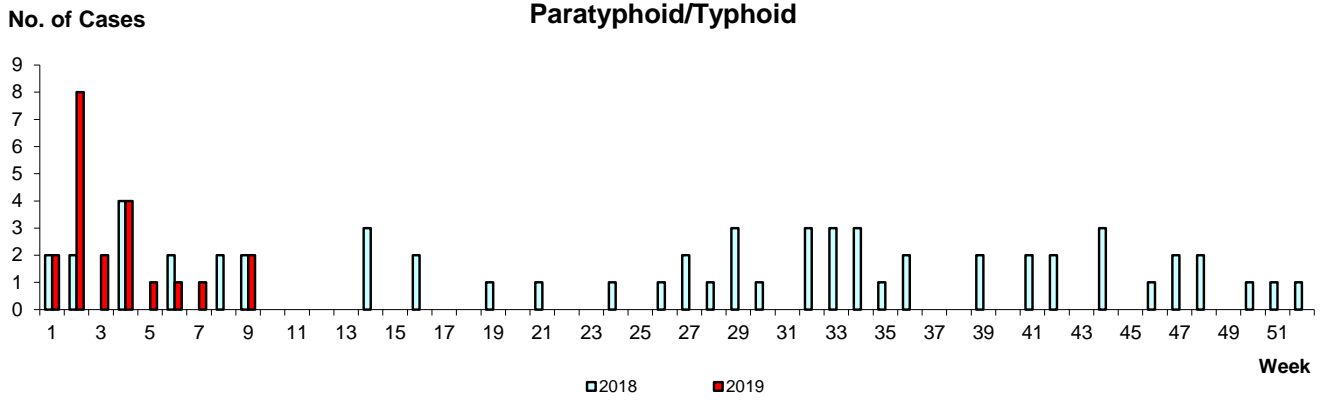
The overall positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n=224) in the community was 37.1% in the past 4 weeks.

Of the specimens tested positive for influenza in Feb 2019, they were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (28.6%), influenza A(H1N1)pdm09 (42.9%) and influenza B (28.6%). 0% of the influenza A specimens were untypable due to low viral titre.



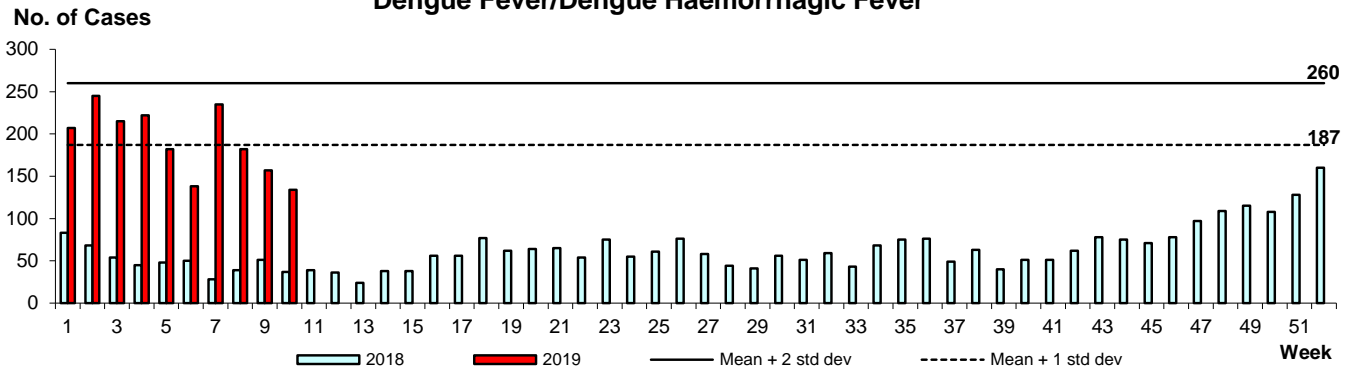

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2018-2019

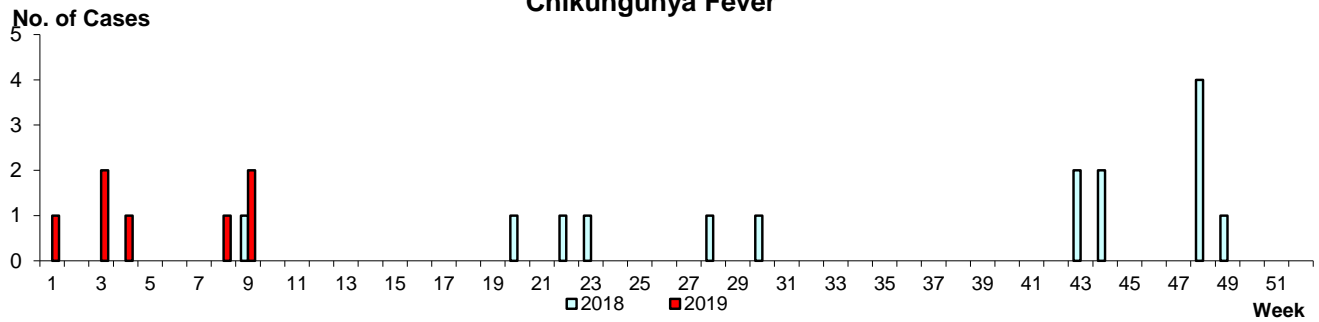

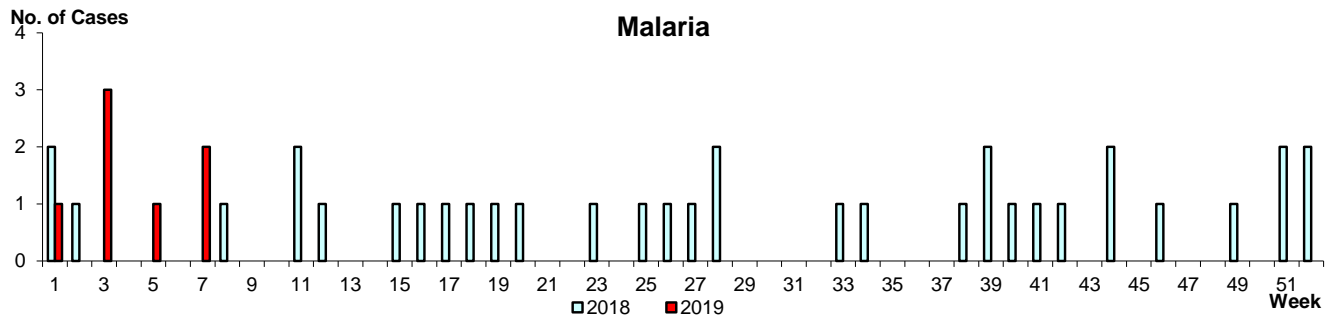

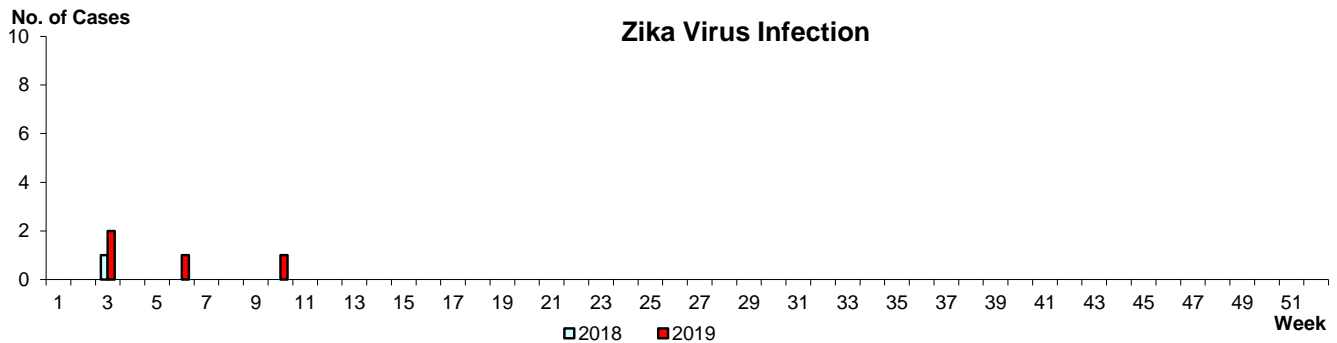

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2018-2019



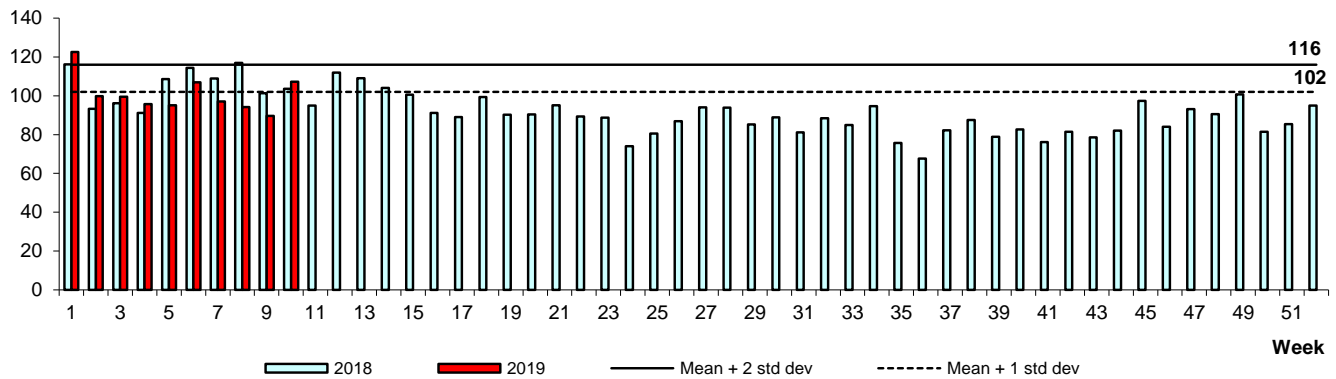

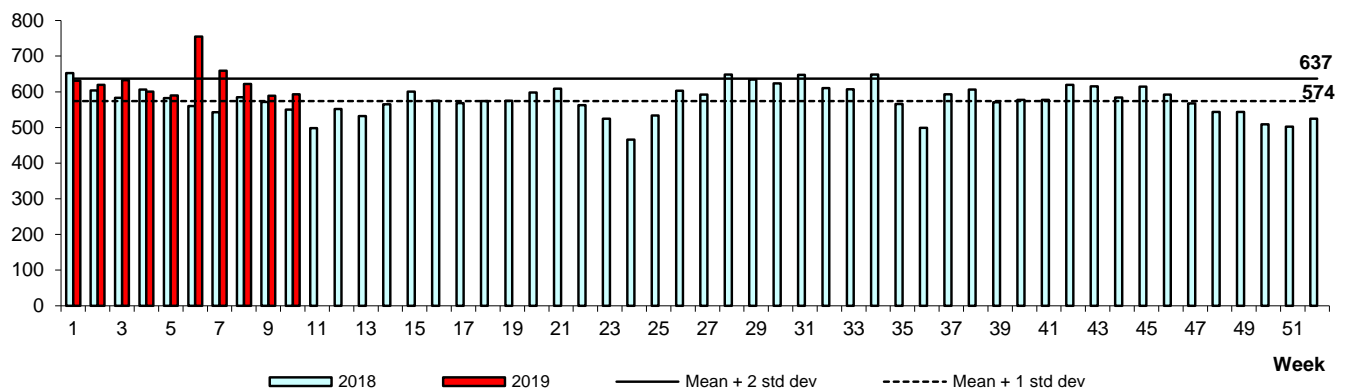
