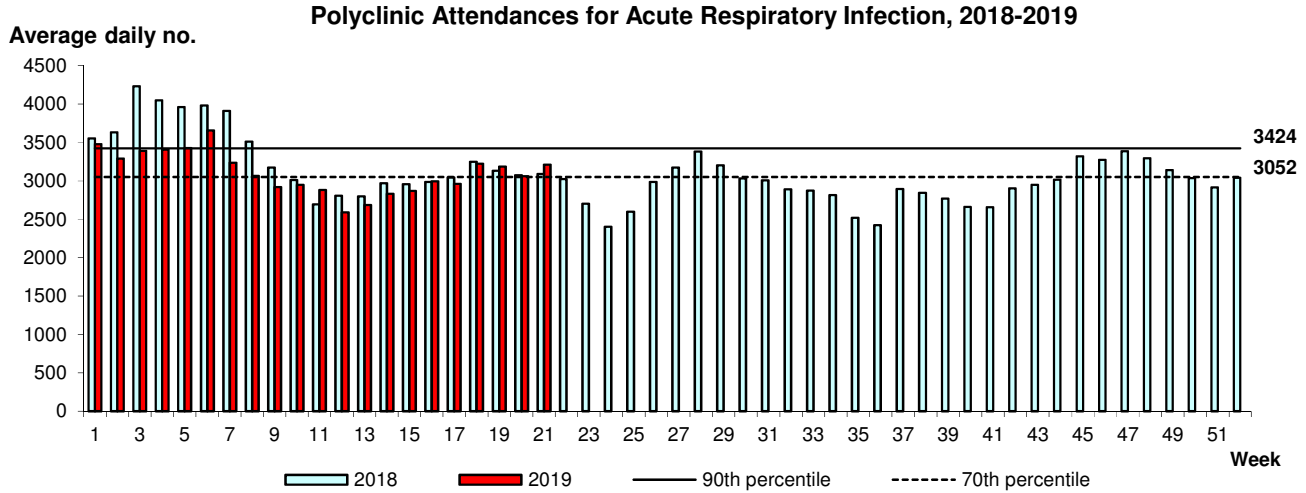

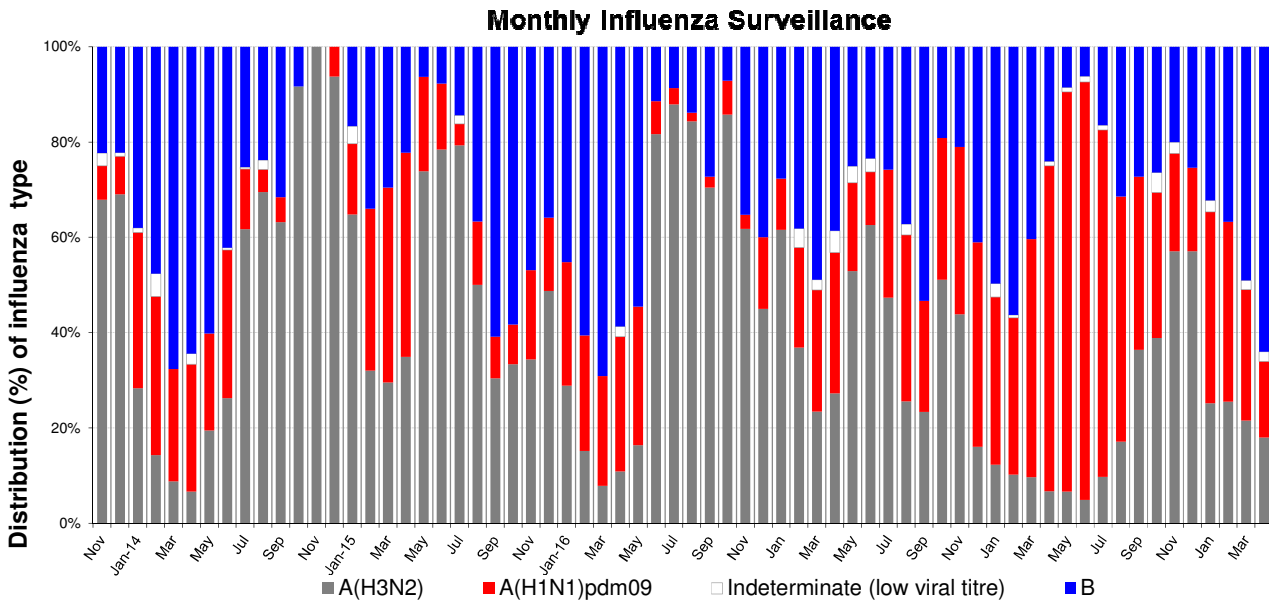
Influenza Situation in Singapore 2019

Influenza indicators for E-week 21 (19 - 25 May 2019) are as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI is 3210 (over 4.5 working days) in E-week 21.

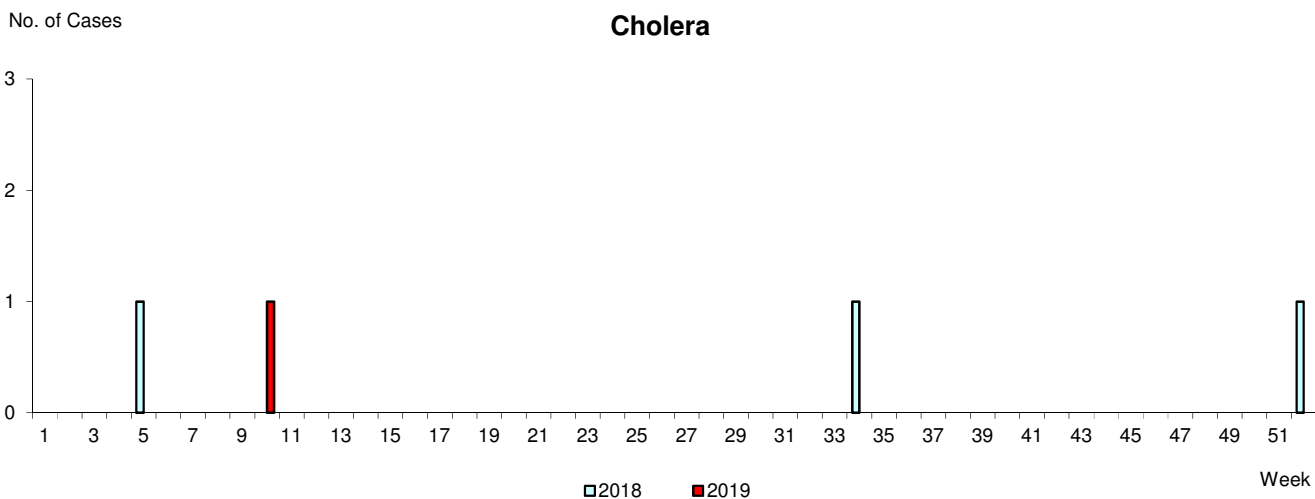
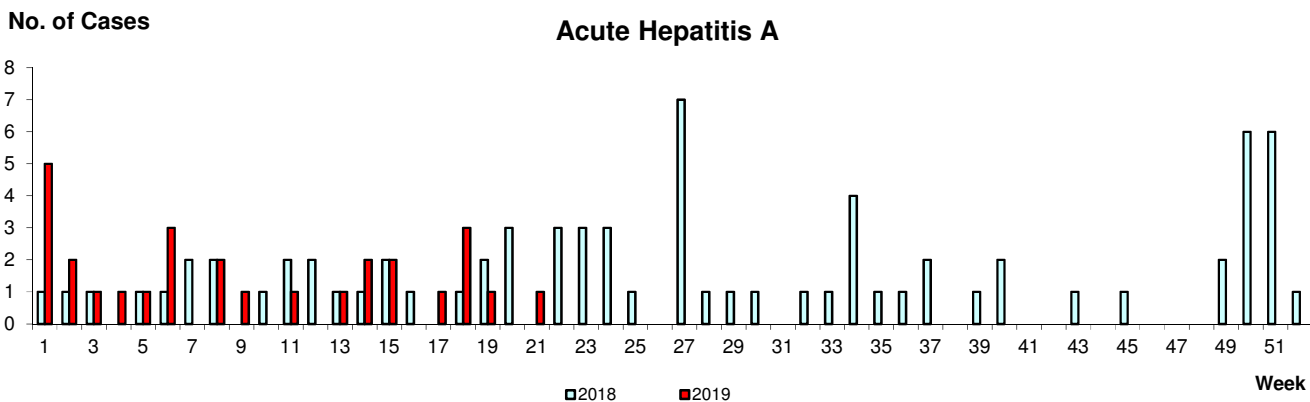
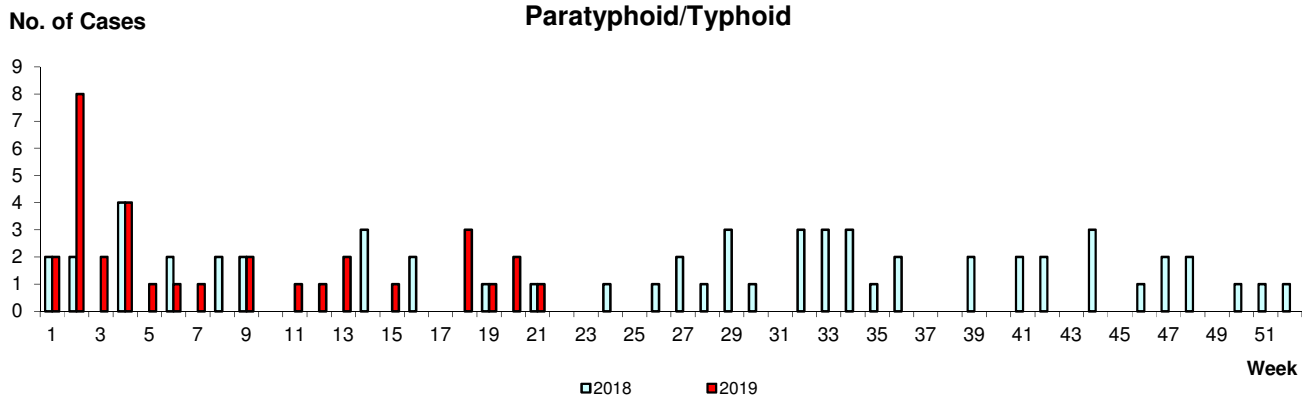


The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI is 2.2%.
 The overall positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n=205) in the community was 25.4% in the past 4 weeks.
 Of the specimens tested positive for influenza in Apr 2019, they were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (18%), influenza A(H1N1)pdm09 (16%) and influenza B (64%). 2% of the influenza A specimens were untypable due to low viral titre.



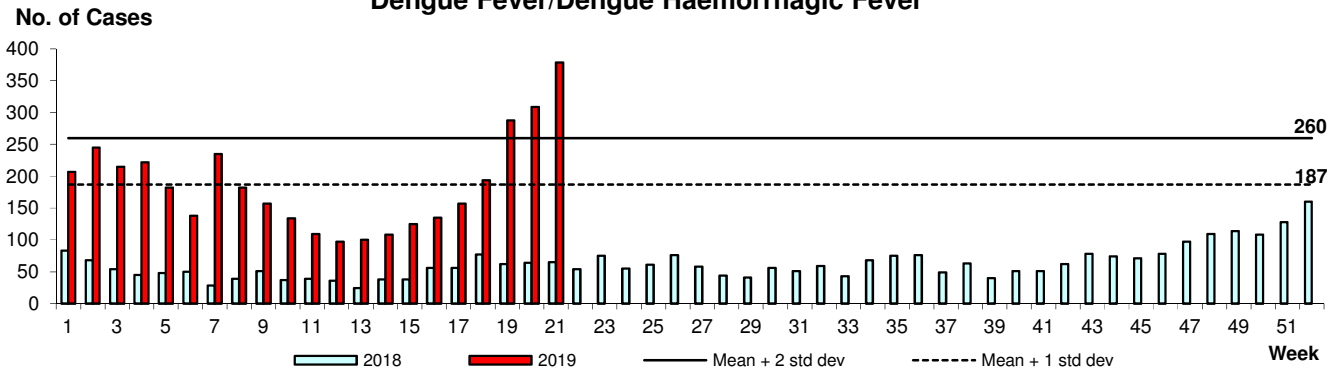

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2018-2019

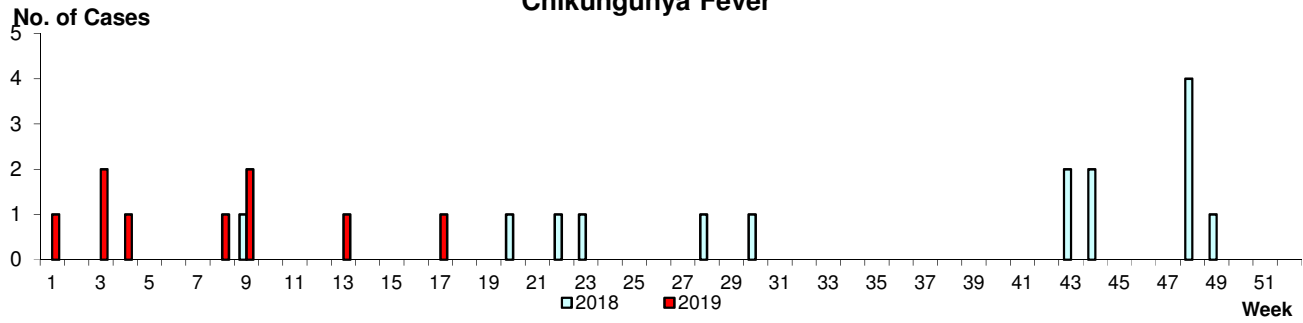

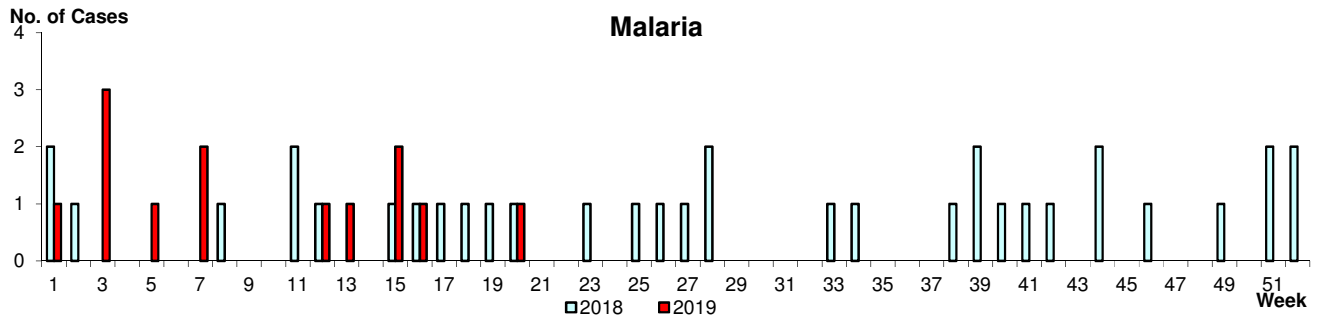

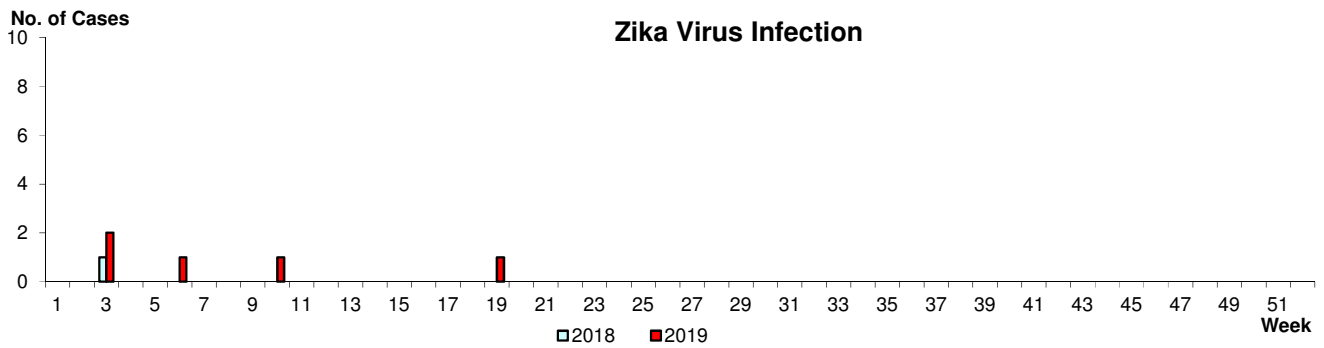

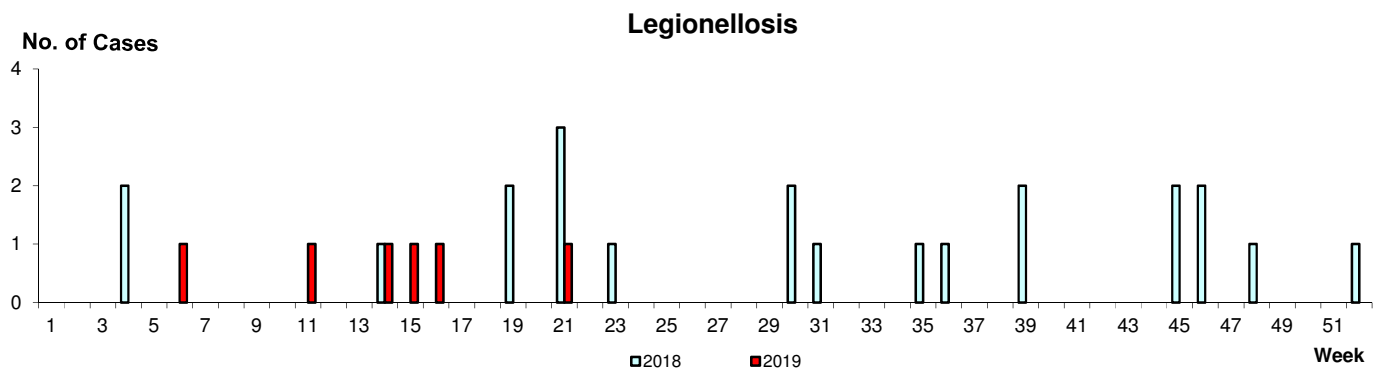

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2018-2019



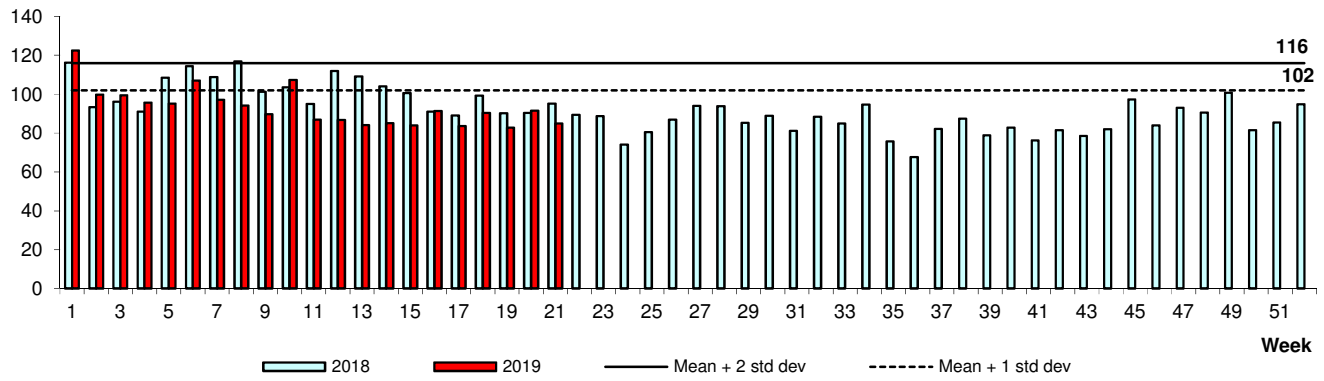

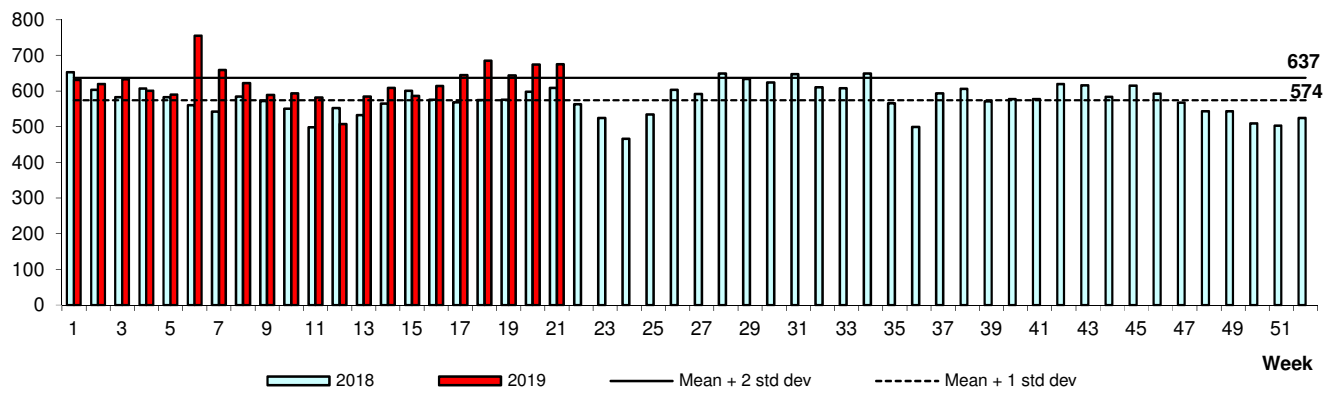
