

**Five Core Parameters to Reset Our SMMs**

<b>Parameter</b>	<b>Current Posture</b>
(1) Group Sizes	No limit
(2) Mask-Wearing	Required on public transport <sup>a</sup> and select healthcare and residential care settings <sup>b</sup>
(3) Workplace Requirements	All can return to office
(4) Safe Distancing	Not required
(5) Capacity Limits	No limit <sup>c</sup>

<sup>a</sup> Public transport settings that require mask-wearing include all public transport (i.e. on MRT/LRT and public buses) and indoor public transport facilities (e.g. boarding areas at bus interchanges and MRT platforms). Mask-wearing will continue to be encouraged in crowded areas.

<sup>b</sup> Healthcare facilities and residential care homes that require mask-wearing include indoor premises of hospitals and polyclinics (inclusive of retail, F&B, common areas and other facilities within the hospital/polyclinic building), private primary care and dental facilities, specialist facilities, TCM clinics, renal dialysis centres, clinical and radiological laboratories, day hospices, residential care homes (such as nursing homes), COVID-19 care facilities, testing centres and vaccination centres and ambulances and medical transport vehicles.

<sup>c</sup> While capacity limits have been lifted, VDS will continue to apply in the following settings: (i) Events with >500 participants at any one time; (ii) Nightlife establishments where dancing among patrons is one of the intended activities; and (iii) F&B establishments, including restaurants, coffee shops and hawker centres.

Types		Is mask-wearing required?
<b>Services</b>		
Public Buses (e.g. Buses operated by SBS Transit, SMRT Buses, Tower Transit, Go-Ahead)		Yes
MRT/ LRT services		
Private bus services* (e.g. school buses, company buses, shuttle buses)		No However, passengers should check with private operators for additional service requirements.
Other train services*		
Taxis / Private Hire Vehicles*		
<b>Premises</b>		
<b>Public Buses</b>	Boarding areas of indoor bus interchanges	Yes
	Naturally ventilated bus interchanges	No
	Retail areas in the premises of bus interchanges	No
<b>MRTs/ LRTs</b>	Boarding areas of underground train platforms	Yes
	Retail areas in the premises of MRT or LRT stations	No
* Private operators may still require mask-wearing as part of company policy.		

**Mask-wearing Requirements for  
Other Transport Settings**

Types	Is mask-wearing required?
<b>Commercial flights and ferries</b>	
Outbound commercial flights and ferries from Singapore to destinations that <u>do not require</u> mask-wearing onboard	No
Outbound commercial flights and ferries from Singapore to destinations that <u>require</u> mask-wearing onboard	Yes
Inbound commercial flights and ferries into Singapore from destinations that <u>do not require</u> mask-wearing onboard	No
Inbound commercial flights and ferries into Singapore from destinations that <u>require</u> mask-wearing onboard for outbound journeys	Yes
Note: Transport operators may still require mask-wearing as part of company policy. Travellers are advised to check with their respective operator prior to their trip on whether the mask-wearing requirement applies for their trip.	



## Mask-wearing Requirements for Healthcare Facilities and Residential Care Homes

Types	Is mask-wearing required?
<b>Healthcare Facilities</b>	
Hospitals, national specialty centres, polyclinics, General Practitioner (GP) and dental clinics	Yes, upon entering indoor premises of the hospital, polyclinic, or clinic
TCM, Specialist, GP and dental clinics located within a shopping mall or area	Yes, upon entering premises of the clinic
COVID-19 care facilities, testing centres and vaccination centres	Yes, upon entering indoor premises of the centre.
Retail & F&B establishments and common areas located within hospital buildings, national specialty centres, and polyclinics	Yes
Physiotherapy and other allied health <sup>1</sup> clinics located outside hospitals	No
Non-residential community services (e.g. centre-based services, day care services, home care services, community mental health services)	No
Retail pharmacies located in a shopping mall	No
Retail establishments and areas in other buildings	No
<b>Residential Care Homes</b>	
Nursing Homes, including inpatient hospices	Yes, upon entering indoor premises
Psychiatric Rehabilitation Homes	
Psychiatric Sheltered Homes	
Welfare Homes and Sheltered Homes for the Aged	
Adult Disability Homes/ Disability Hostels	
<b>Medical Transport</b>	
Emergency Ambulances and Medical Transport vehicles	Yes, while in the vehicle
