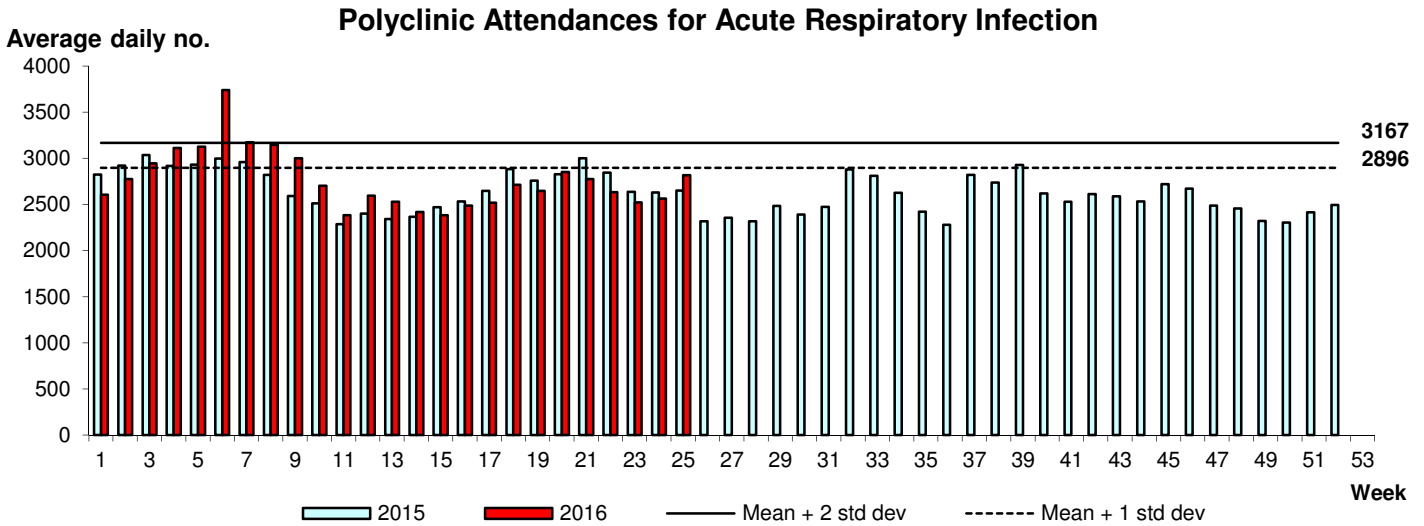

Influenza Situation in Singapore 2016

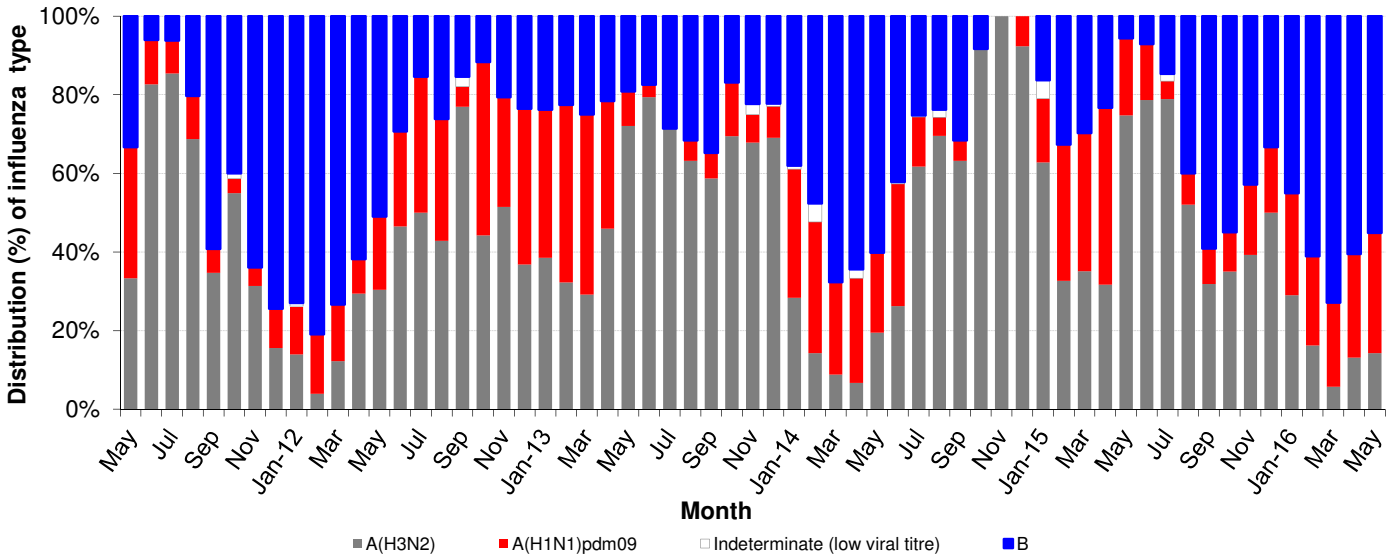
Influenza indicators for E-week 25 (19 - 25 Jun 2016) are as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI increased from 2,564 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 24 to 2,819 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 25.

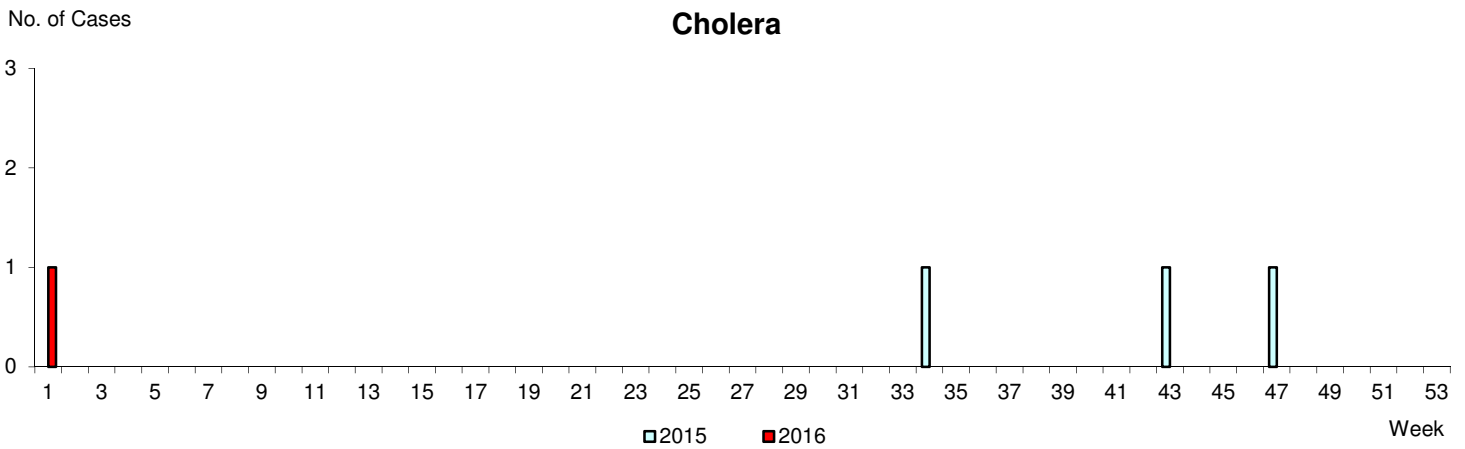
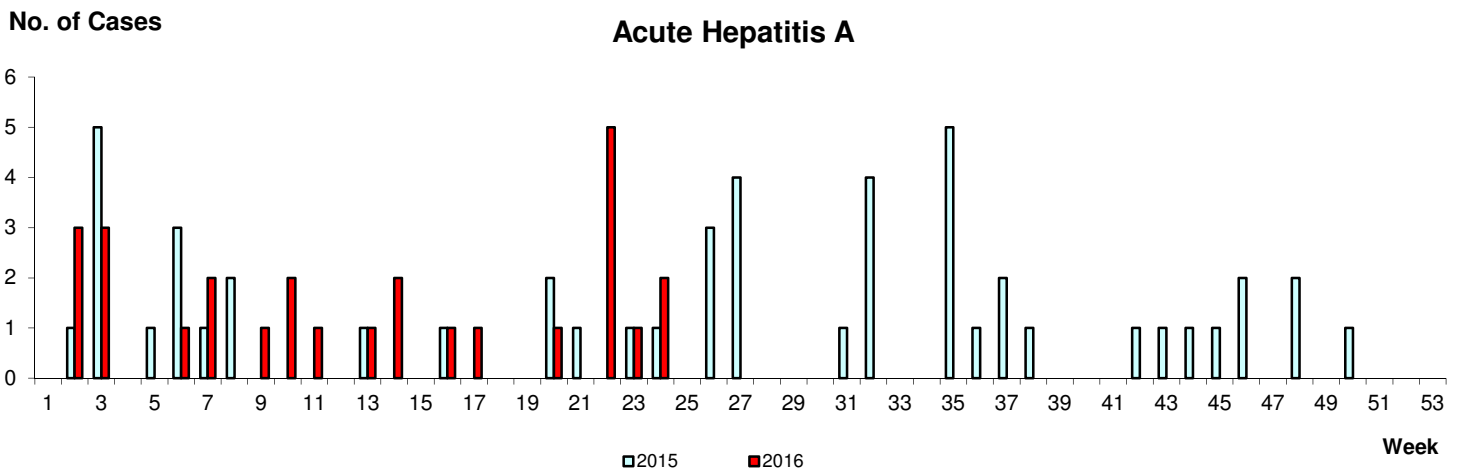
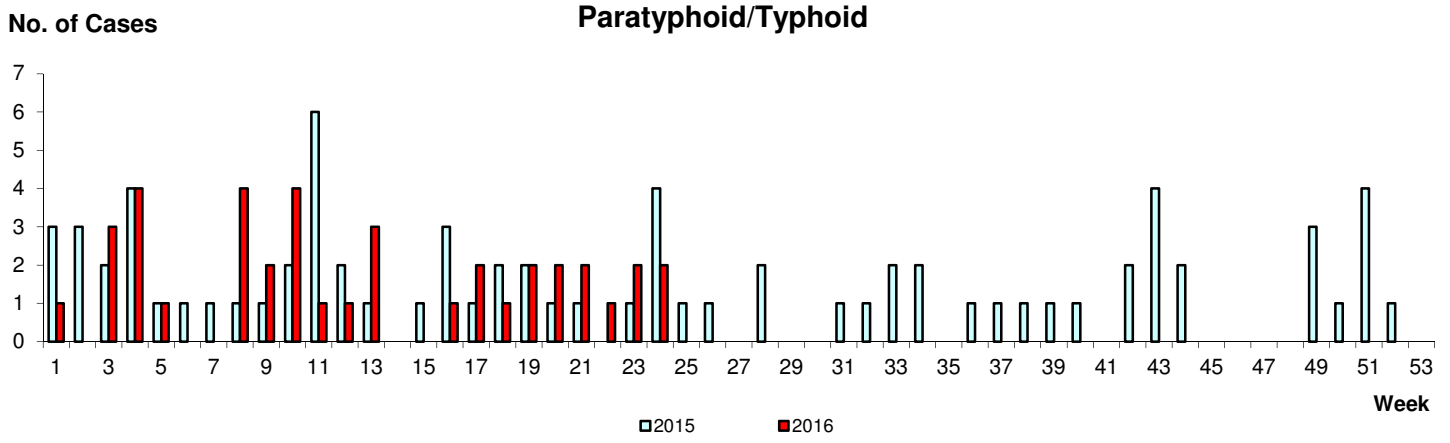


The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI remained low at 2.1%. The overall prevalence of influenza among ILI samples (n=130) in the community was 63.1% in the past 4 weeks. Of the specimens tested positive for influenza in May 2016, these were positive for influenza B (55.1%), influenza A (H1N1)pdm09 (30.6%), and influenza A(H3N2) (14.3%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance



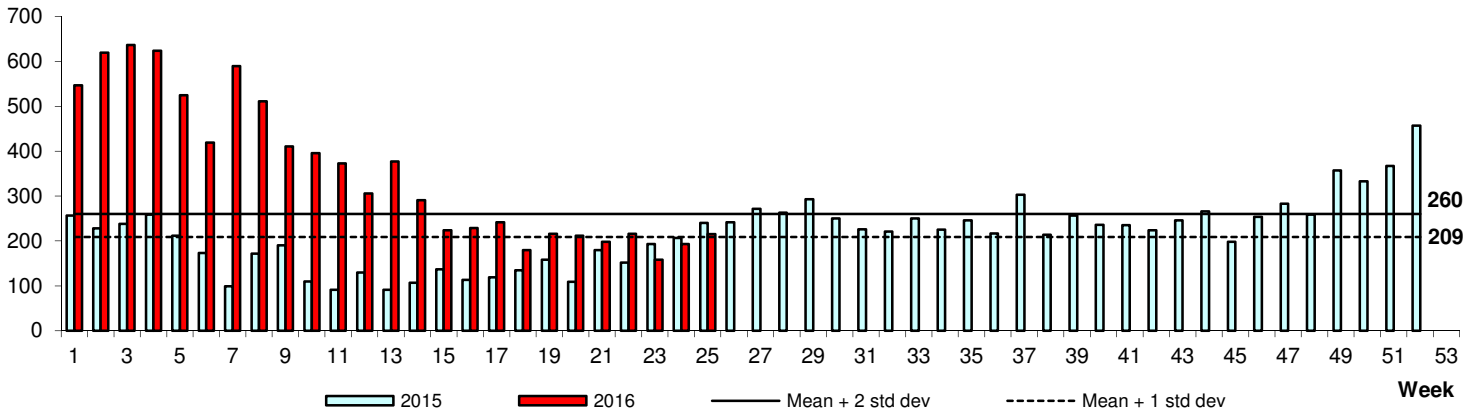

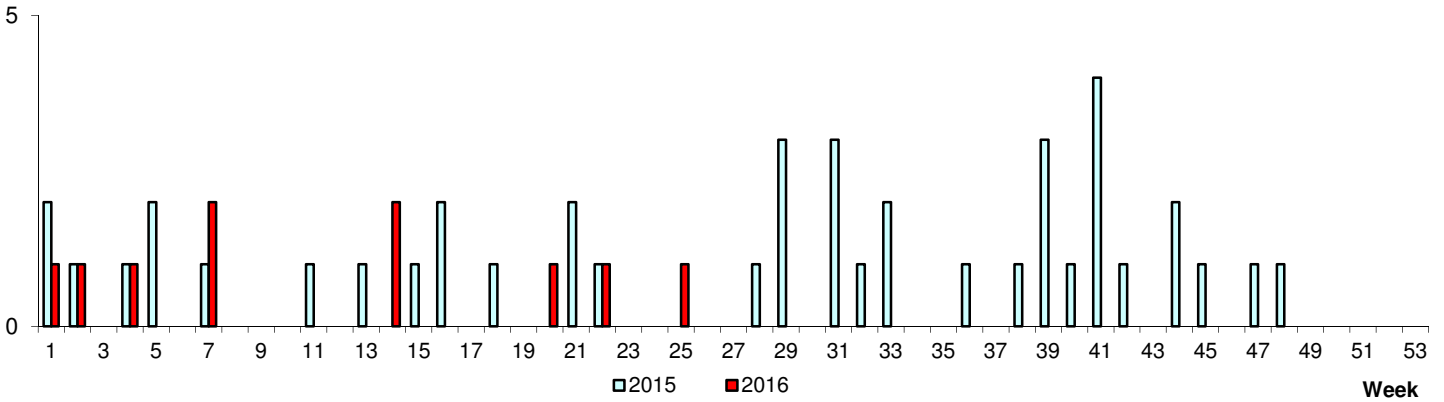
Dengue Fever/Dengue Haemorrhagic Fever

No. of Cases



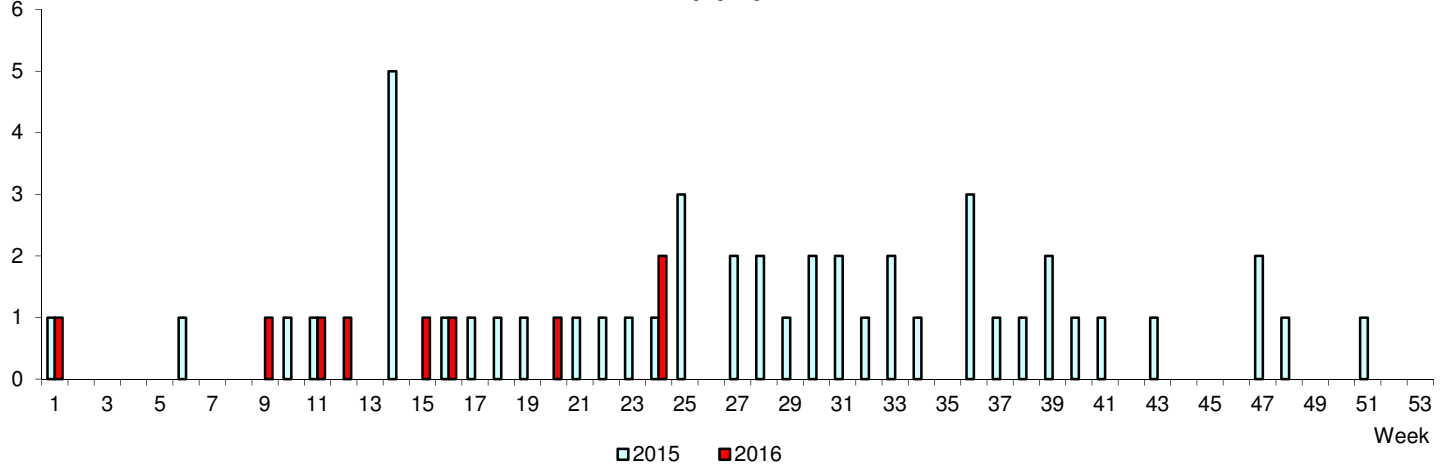
Chikungunya Fever

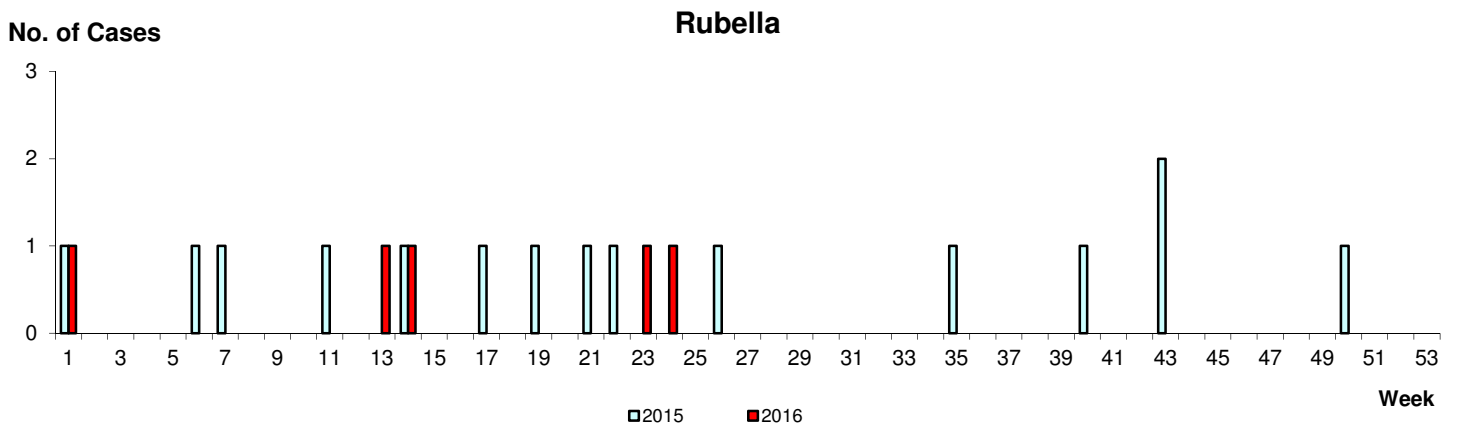

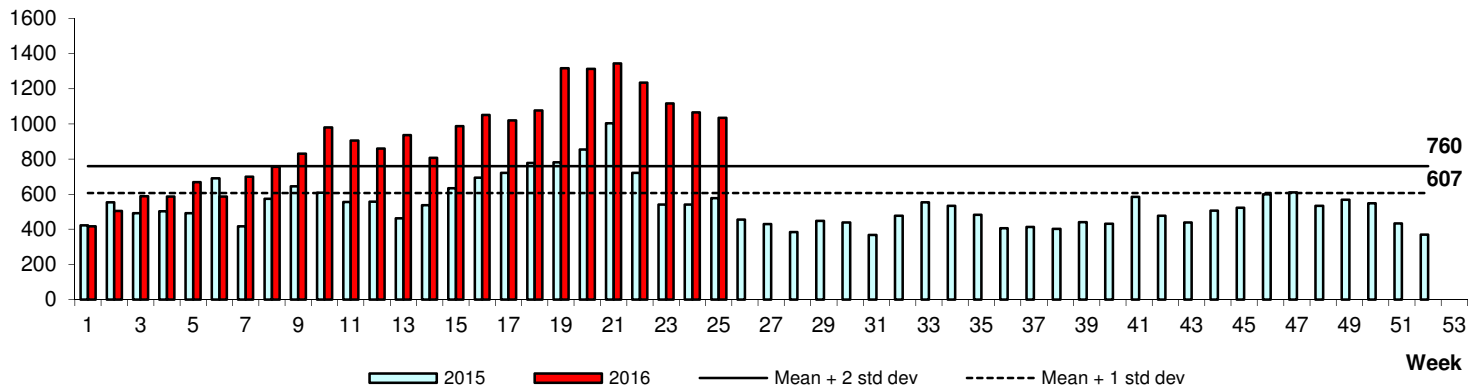


WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2015-2016

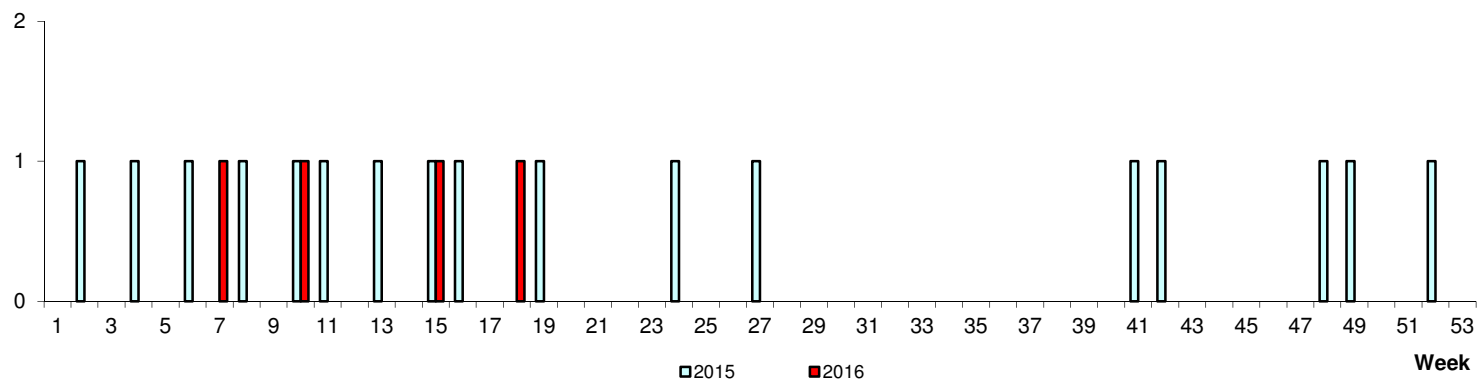

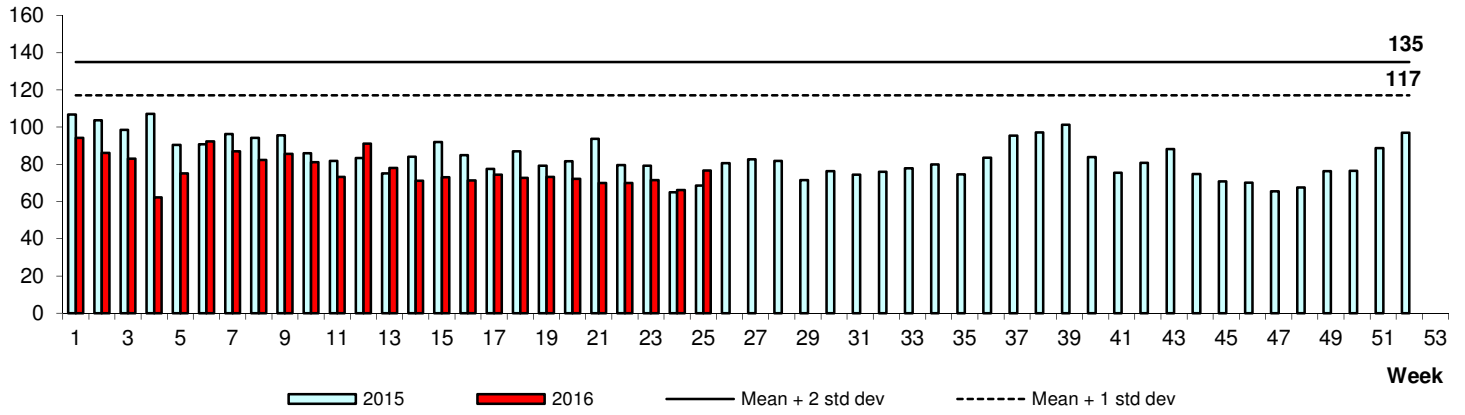
