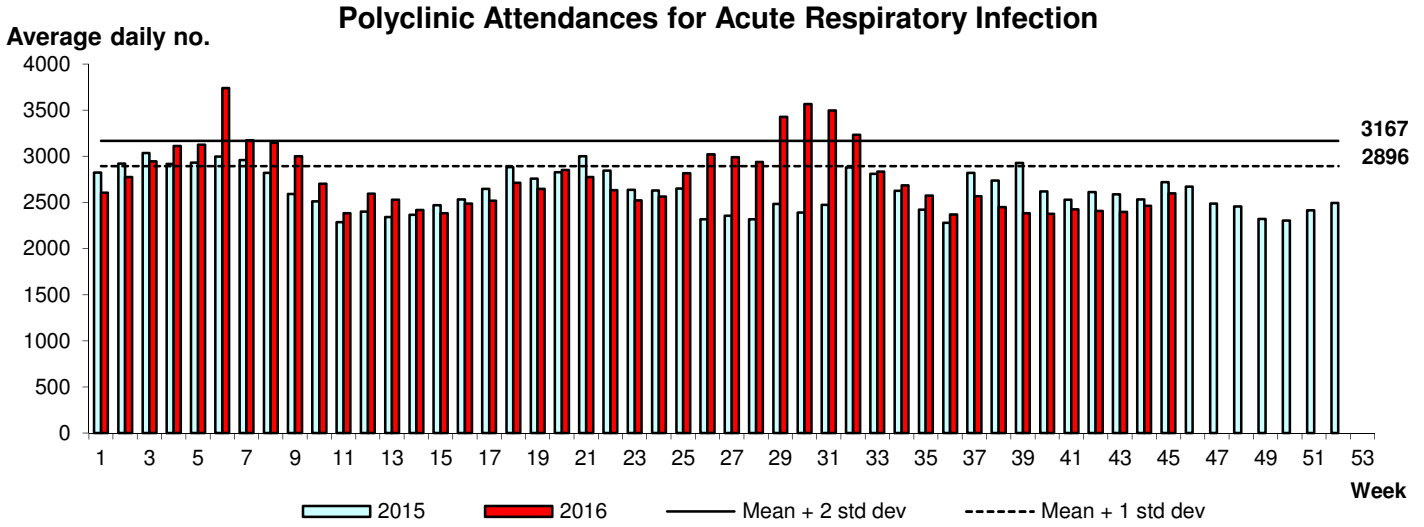

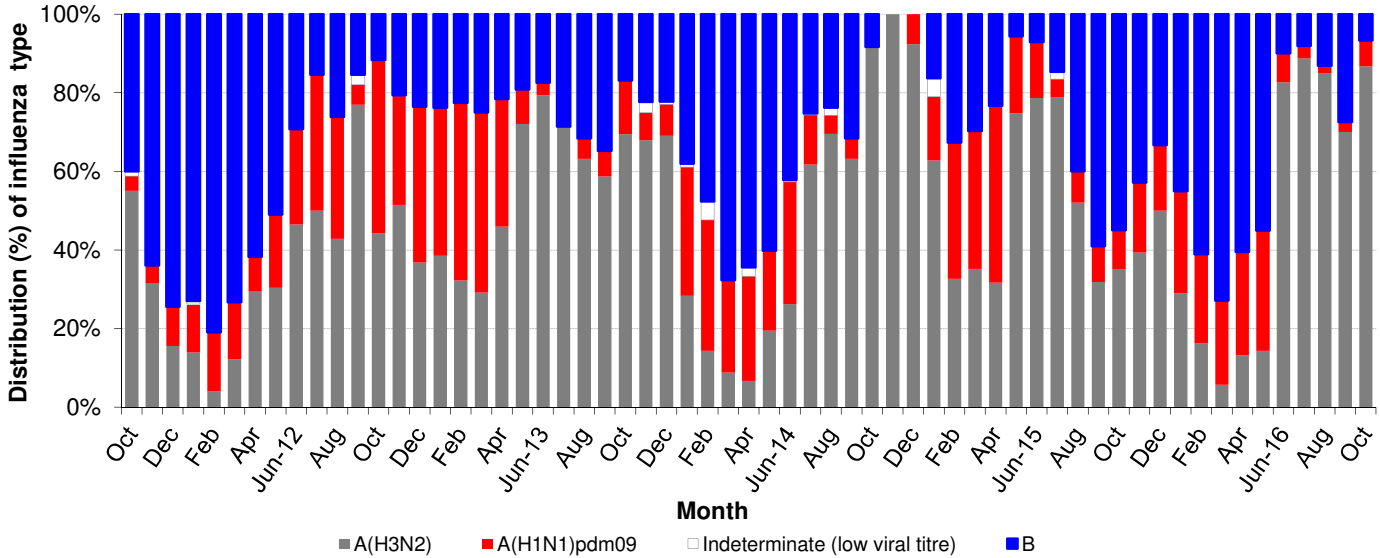
Influenza indicators for E-week 45 (6 - 12 Nov 2016) are as follows:

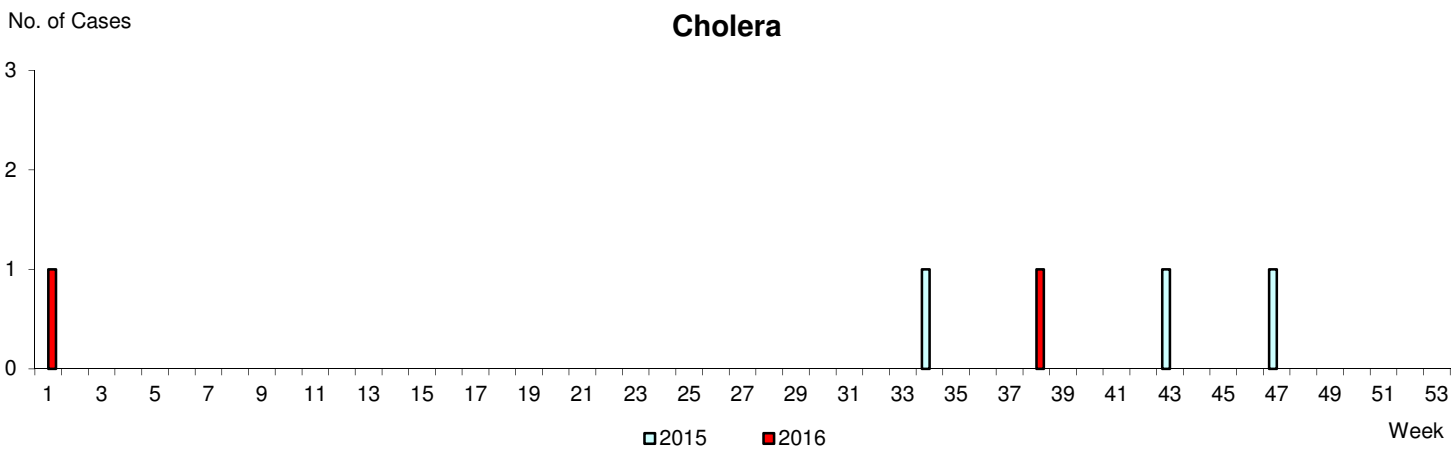
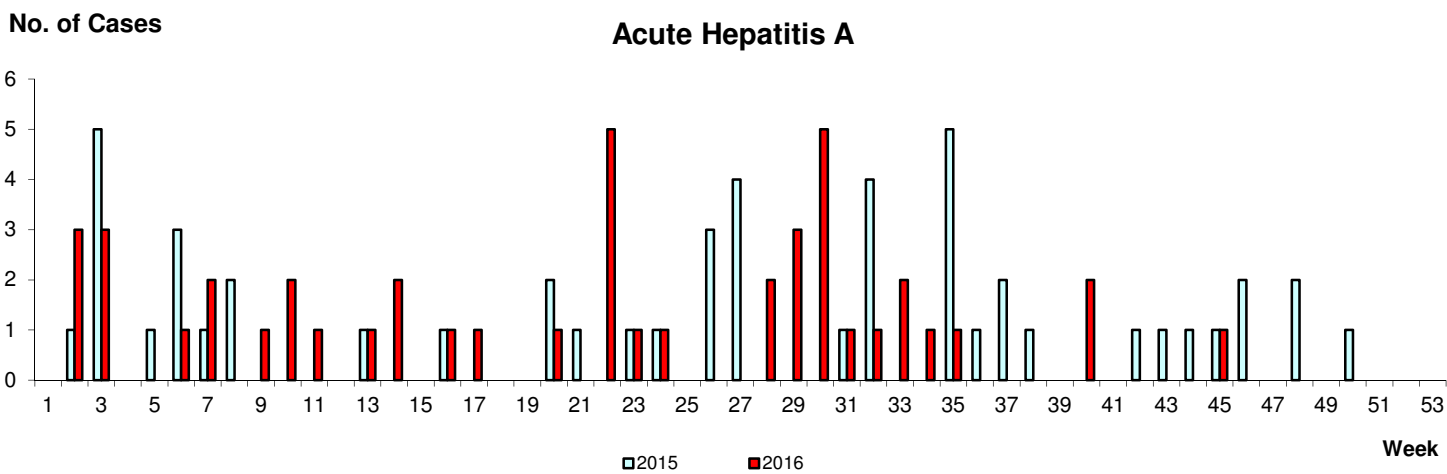
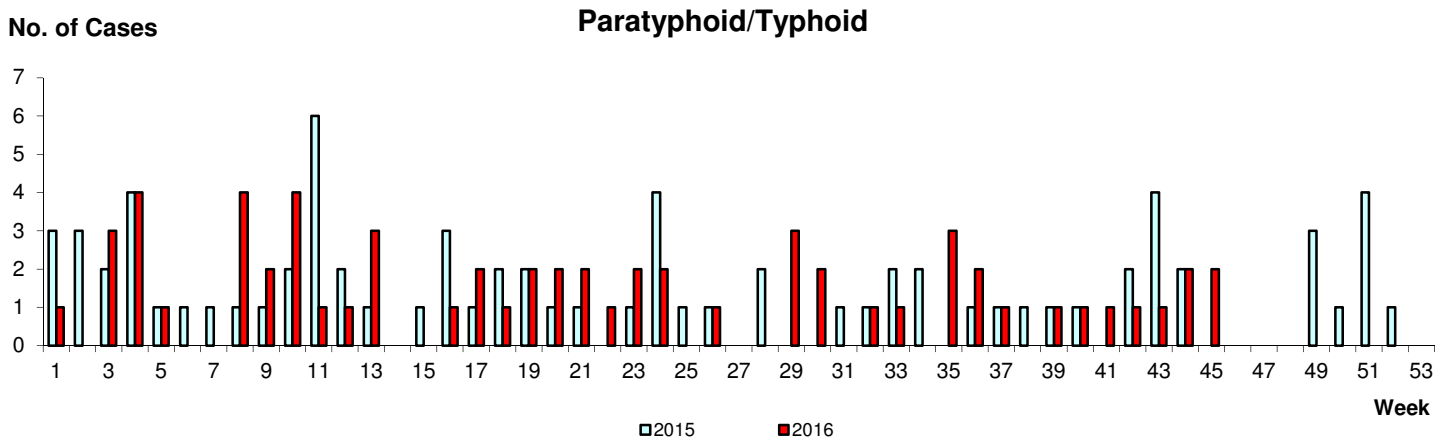
The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI increased from 2,462 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 44 to 2,598 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 45.



The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI remained low at 1.0%. The overall positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n=51) in the community was 31.4% in the past 4 weeks. Of the specimens tested positive for influenza in October 2016, these were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (86.7%), influenza A(H1N1)pdm09 (6.7%) and influenza B (6.7%).

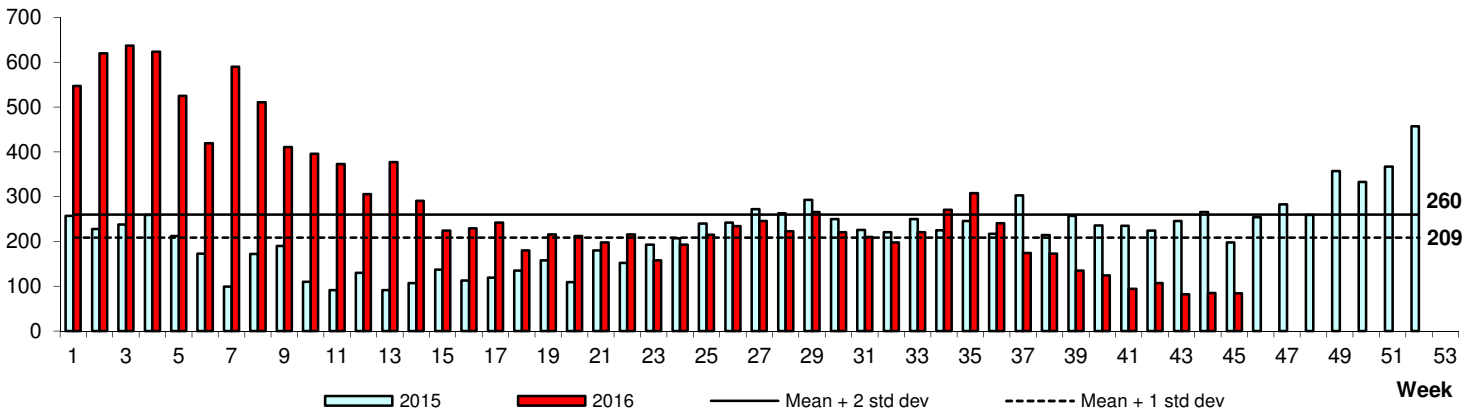
Monthly Influenza Surveillance





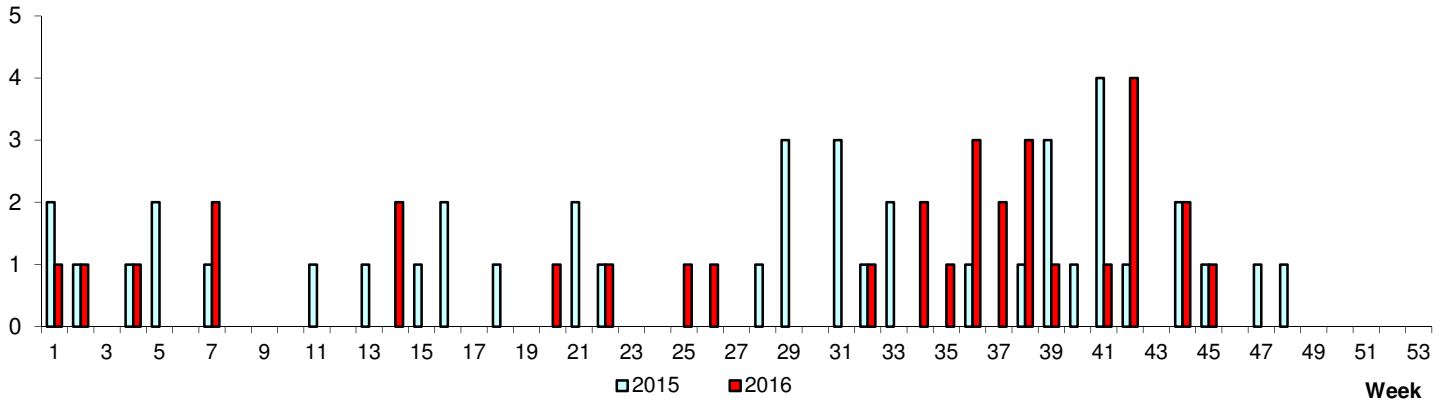
Dengue Fever/Dengue Haemorrhagic Fever

No. of Cases



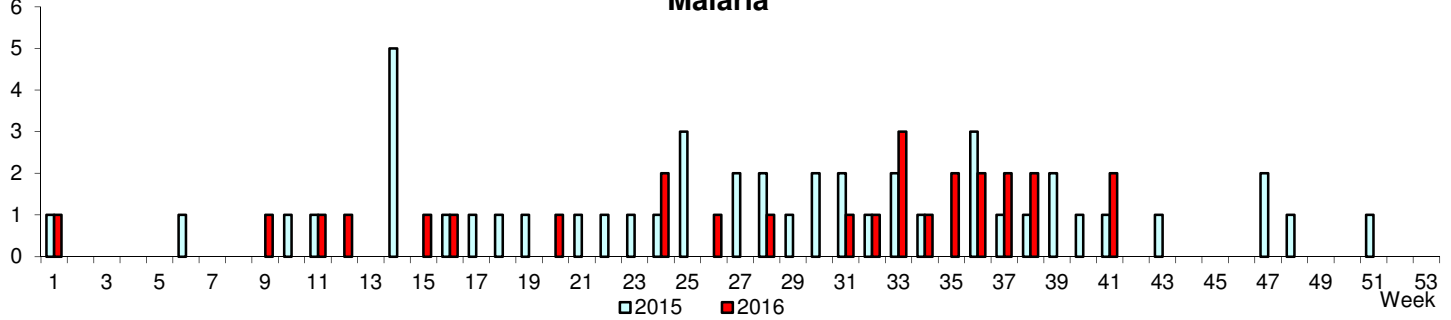
Chikungunya Fever

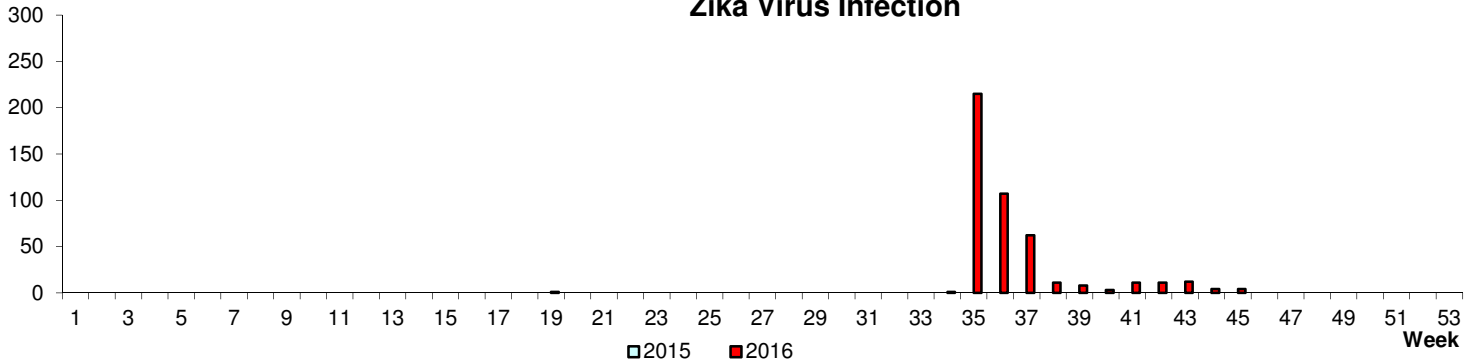

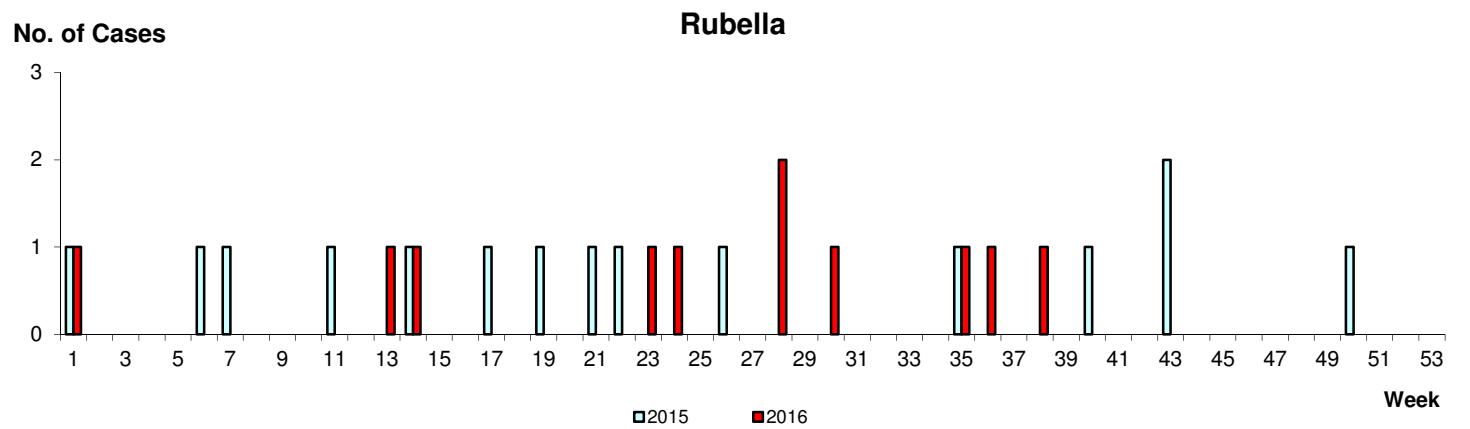
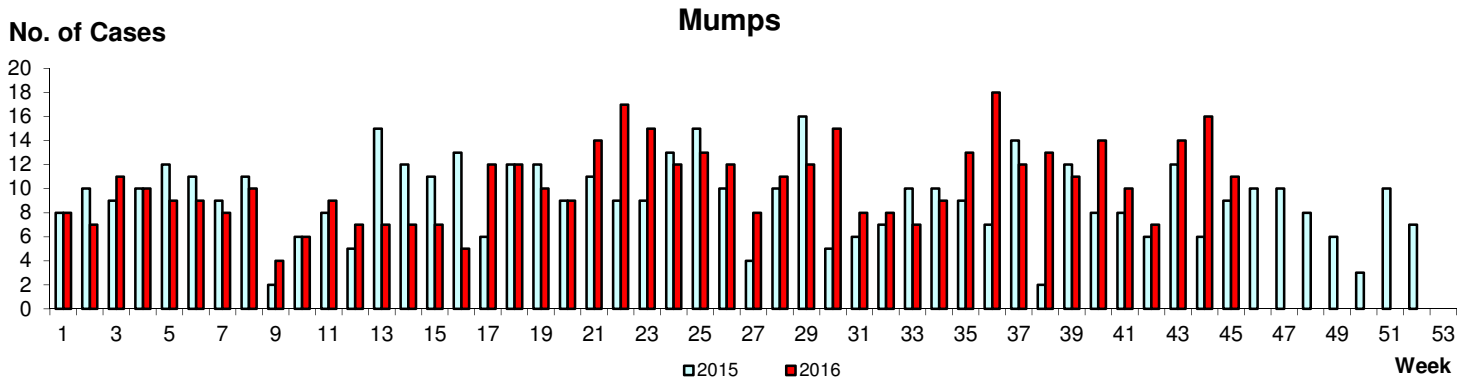
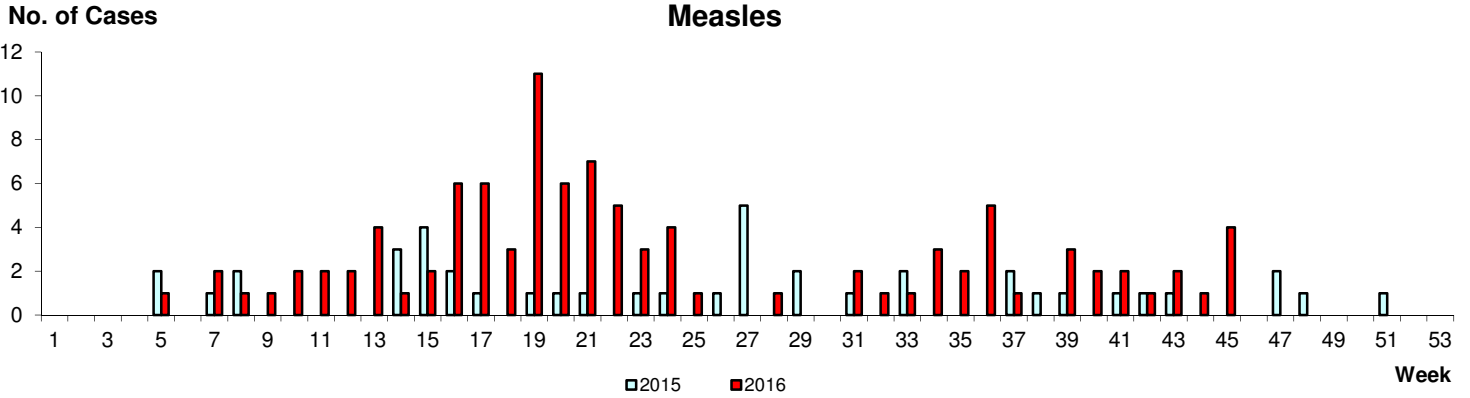


Zika Virus Infection

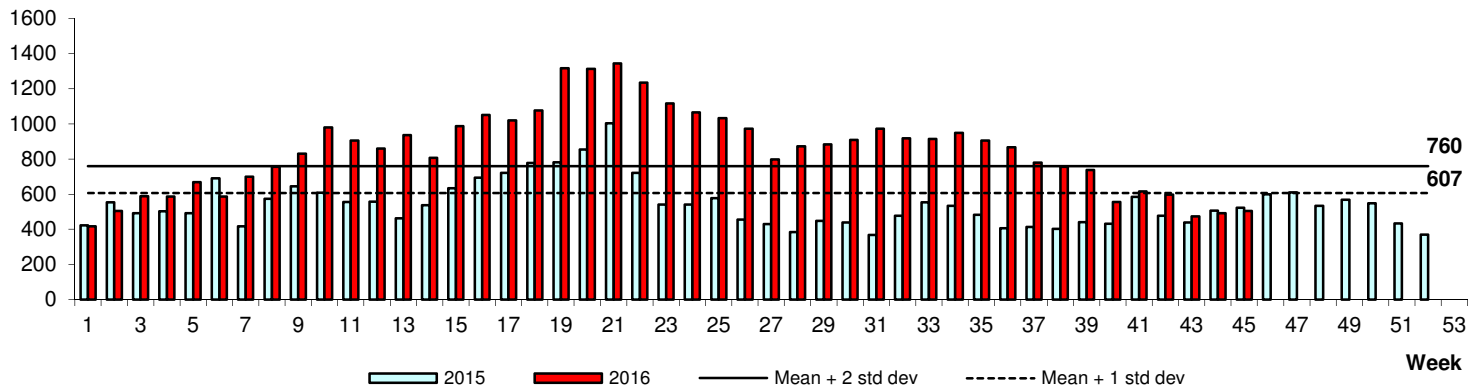


WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2015-2016

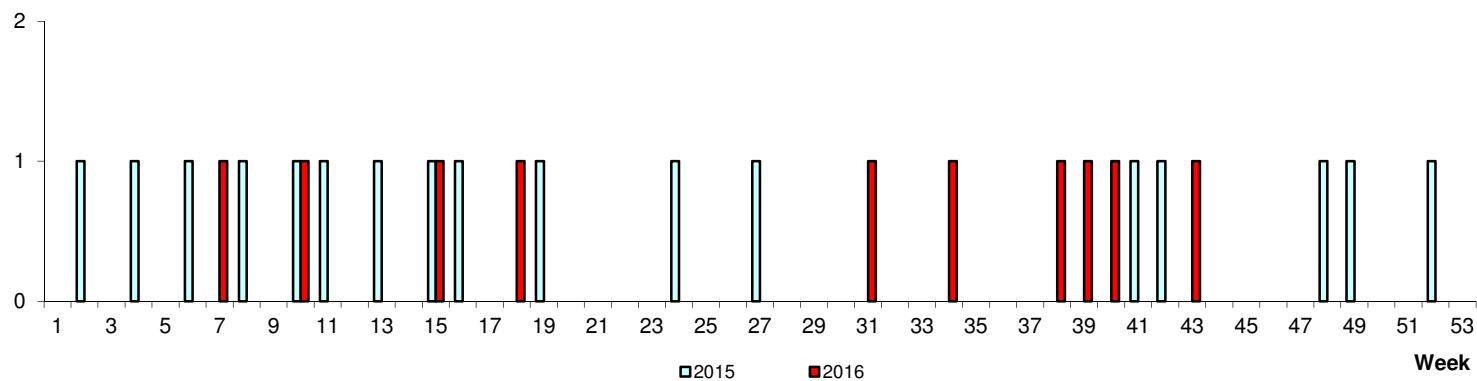

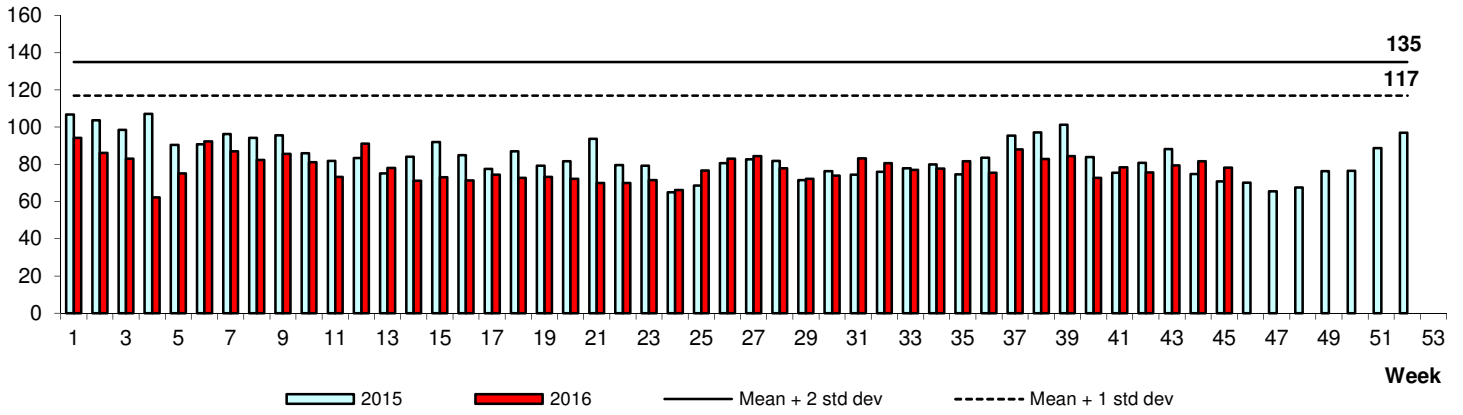
