

POPULATION PROFILE

In 2007, Singapore had an estimated population of 4.59 million, with a resident population of 3.58 million. The female-to-male ratio in the resident population was 1.02. The ethnic distribution in the resident population showed a Chinese majority of 75.0%, followed by Malays and Indians at 13.7% and 8.8% respectively.

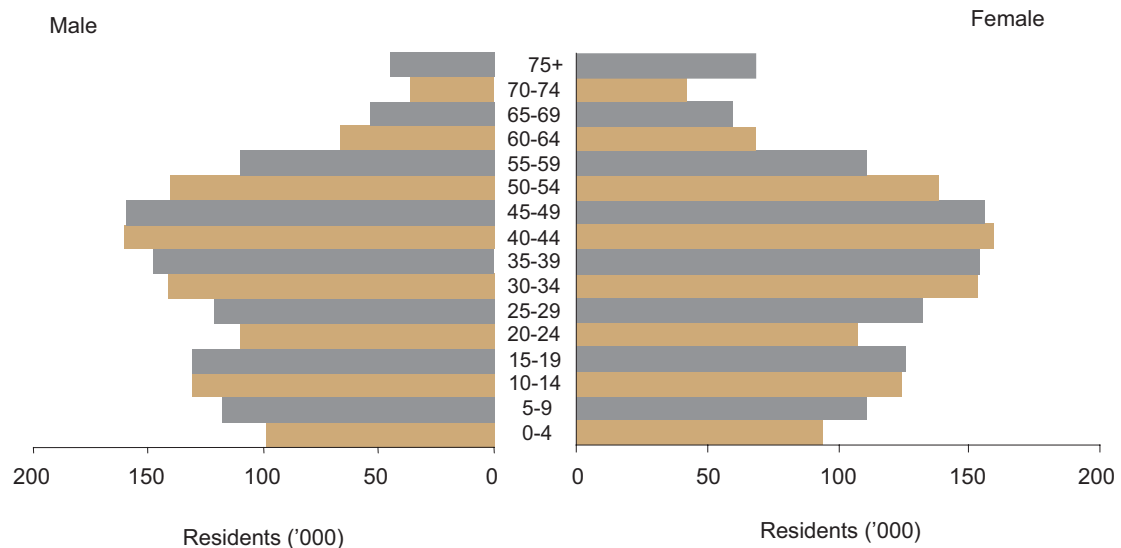
The aging pattern of Singapore's population is shown in the age pyramid below. The proportion of 15 to 64 year ages has increased while the proportion of children under 15 years has steadily declined from 28% in 1980 to 18.9% in 2007. Currently 8.5% of Singapore residents are aged 65 years and above.
