KEY OFFICEHOLDERS

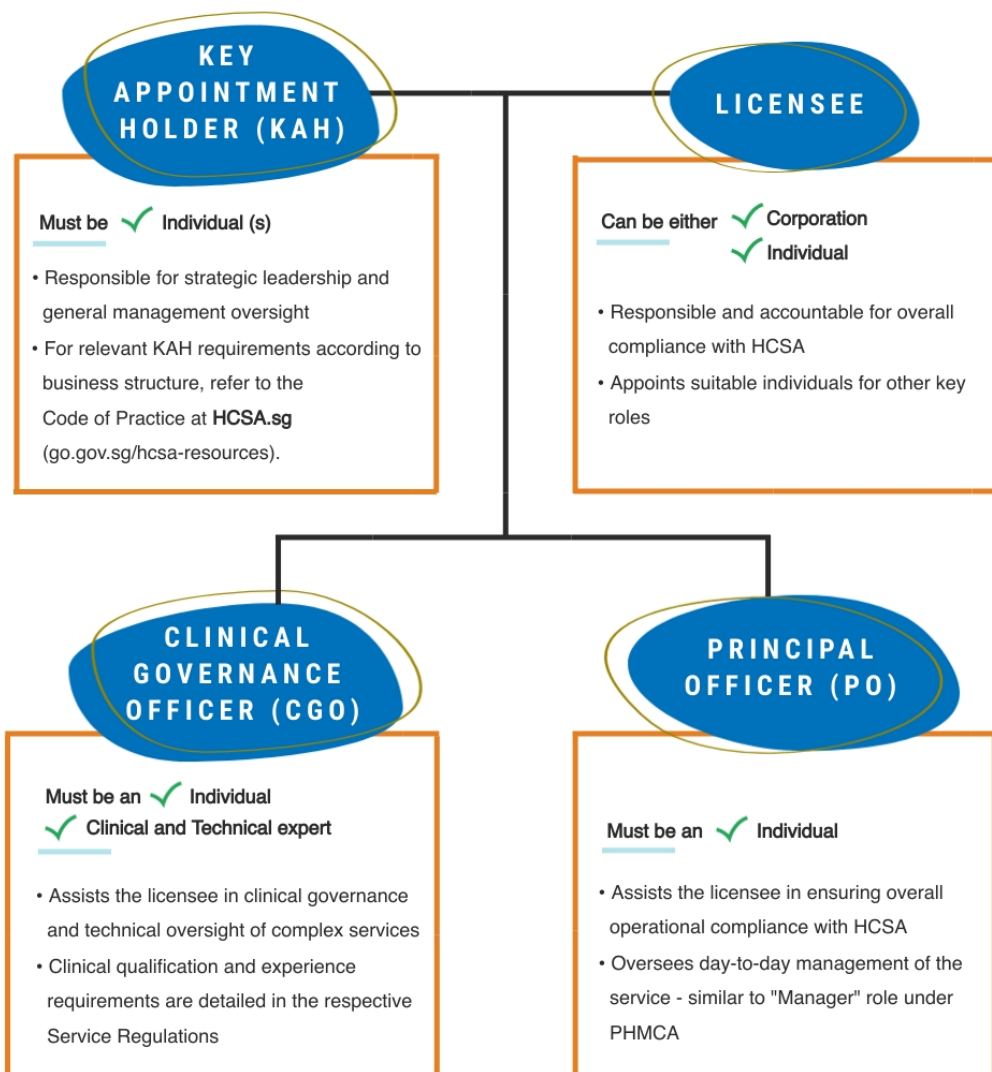
The **Healthcare Services Act (HCSA)** strengthens governance and accountability of licensees, by prescribing requirements for Key Officeholders (KOH) who manage the service.

The Code of Practice for KOHs provides guidance on the minimum standards and requirements for KOHs and is applicable to all licensees.

CGOs are required for the following Phase 1 services:

- Blood Banking
- Clinical Laboratory
- Nuclear Medicine Imaging
- Emergency Ambulance
- Cord Blood Banking
- Radiological Service
- Nuclear Medicine Assay
- Medical Transport

Phase 2 and 3 services requiring CGOs are to be confirmed and details will be provided separately nearer to the implementation of these services.

For small providers (e.g. solo-practitioner clinic), a single individual can assume the roles of the various KOHs (where applicable) as long he/she meets all the requirements for the relevant roles.
